7. It also transpires from the petition that the petitioner Institute is un-aided institution (Higher Secondary). During the academic year 2023-24, out of total 439 students, 06 students were from the Jain minority community. In the year 2024-25, out of total 547 students, 14 students were from the Jain minority community and in the year 2025-26, out of total 650 students, 21 students belong to Jain minority community.

8. In this petition the supplementary trust deed of the petitioner trust was executed prior to the filing application u/s 10 of NCMEI Act. 2004 before the State Competent Authority and also petition before this Commission for grant of Minority Status Certificate.

9. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to file envelope and postage charges for sending notice to the respondent.

10. After compliance, office is directed to issue notice to the respondents by registered AD and e-mail. Learned counsel for the petitioner is also directed to file certified copies of all the relevant documents.
