An internal communication has been received from the Additional District Commissioner, i/c Administration Branch, Kamrup Metropolitan Dist., Guwahati, Assam, which is taken on record.

Though this case is listed for final hearing, but some variance was observed in the report and petition.

A bare reading of the PIR makes it clear that during the academic year 2022-23, out of 786 students, only 16 students were from the Christian minority community, which is 2%. In the year 2023-24, out of 789 students, only 25 students were from the Christian minority community, which is 3.16%. In the year 2024-25, out of 720 students, only 20 students are Christians, which is 2.7%.

It is stated against column no. 6 of the application filed by the petitioner for grant of minority status certificate that in the year 2020-21, out of 798 students, only 16 students were from the Christian minority community, which is 2%.

Population of Christian minority community in the State of Assam as per the census of 2011 is 3.74%. It appears from the petition as well as from the physical inspection report that the percentage of students belonging to Christian minority community in the petitioner institution is less.
