## <u>ORDER</u>

- 1. This petition has been received on 27.09.2022 by hand through Mr. Jose Abraham, Advocate of the petitioner institution for grant of Minority Status Certificate (in short 'MSC') toGolden Independent Pre-University College, Bagur Sonnenahalli, Lakkur Hobli, Chikkathirupathi Post, Malur Taluk, Kolar Dist., Karnataka 563160.
- 2. Learned counsel for the petitioner filed an affidavit of Mr. A. Iqbal Khan, Managing Trustee of Golden Educational and Social Charitable Trustin support of the averments made in the petition and also to prove that the beneficiaries of the petitioner institution are members of the Muslimminority community and also stating therein that the petitioner institution shall not deny admission of eligible candidate of the Muslim minority community subject to the eligibility of the students and availability of the accommodation in the petitioner institution.
- 3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has filed copy of Unique ID No.: KA/2019/0242701 of the petitioner's Trust as given by the Niti Aayog Portal NGO Darpan, photocopy of application dated 17.09.2019 sent to the State Competent Authority i.e. Additional Chief Secretary, Department of Higher Education, Govt. of Karnataka alongwith postal receipt and its tracking report,notarized copy of Trust Deed alongwith founding members of the trust,notarized copy of Amended Trust Deed alongwith present members of the trust,notarized copy of affiliation order dated 30.05.2016 issued by Joint Director(Recognition and Grant in Aid) Pre University Education Departmentwhich is in Kannad language alongwith its English translationand original resolution of the General Body of the Trust in favour ofMr. A. Iqbal Khan, Managing Trustee of Golden Educational and Social Charitable Trustfor obtaining MSC from this Commission.
  - 4. As per the information supplied by the petitioner unaided institution with regard to students strength as on Academic Year 2020-21, it is mentioned that out of total 136 students, 72 students were from the Muslim minority community and

64students were Hindu, In the year 2021-22, it is mentioned that out of total 126 students, 76 students were from the Muslim minority community and 50 students were Hindu, and in the year 2022-23, it is mentioned that out of total 117 students, 67 students were from the Muslim minority community and 50 students were Hindu. It is relevant to mention here in the academic year 2020-21, out of the total 11 teachers, 07 students were from the Muslim minority community, 01 student was from the Christian minority community and 03 students were Hindu, In the academic year 2021-22, out of the total 11 teachers, 05 students were from the Muslim minority community, 01 student was from the Christian minority community and 05 students were Hinduandin the academic year 2022-23, out of the total 11 teachers, 05 students were from the Muslim minority community, 01 student was from the Christian minority community and 05 students were Hindu.

- 5. It is stated in the petition that on dated 17.09.2019, the petitioner institution has applied to the State Competent Authority for grant of NOC which was received by the State Competent Authority on 18.09.2019and the said application is still pending before the State Competent Authority. The State Competent Authority has not granted NOC in favour of the petitioner institution till now and also not rejected the said application and not communicated the same to the petitioner. After 90 days from the receipt of the application for grant of NOC, the petitioner has filed this petition for grant of MSC to this Commission straightway as per the provisions of Section 10 and 11(f) of National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions (in short 'NCMEI') Act, 2004.
- 6. After service of registered noticedated 07.11.2022, 20.03.2023, 20.06.2023 and 02.09.2025, no reply/ response has received from the respondent. Thereafter in the facts and circumstances of the case, Commission deemed fit and proper that physical inspection report alongwith recommendation may be obtained from the Committee constituted by this Commission for issuance of MSC to the petitioner institution vide order dated 08.12.2022. After service of letter/emails to the physical inspection committee dated 30.12.2022 and reminders dated, 20.03.2023, 20.06.2023, 12.09.2023, 17.11.2023, 27.12.2023, 23.02.2024, 09.05.2024, 27.08.2024 and 28.10.2024, Physical Inspection Committee, has sent letter dated 19.10.2024, which was received by post in the Commission's Office on dated 28.10.2024 which was duly signed by members of the physical Inspection Committee wherein they have recommended to grant minority status certificate to the petitioner institution.
- 7. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, perused the pleading of the petitioner, the documents filed by the petitioner and affidavit of Mr. A. Iqbal Khan, Managing Trustee of Golden Educational and Social Charitable Trust.
- 8. Hon'ble Apex Court, various High Courts as well as this Commission in case of Buckley Primary School, Cuttack, Orissa Vs. Government of Orissa (order passed by the Commission in Case No. 1320 of 2009 dated 6.7.2010) have categorically held that the percentage of admission of students from notified minority community in a minority educational institution is not an indicia for determining the minority status of such institution. This Commission has also decided that there must be reasonable strength of students of particular minority community in a minority educational institution. The percentage could be determined based on the actual proportion of specific minority community in the State population as per prevailing census. Population of Muslim minority community in the State of Karnataka as per the census of 2011 is 12.92%.
- 9. The petitioner institution has applied for grant of minority status certificate on the ground that the same has been established primarily for the benefit of the members of the Muslim minority community and is being administered by Golden Educational and Social Charitable Trustwhich is managed and run by the members of the Muslim minority community. The aforesaid averments made in the petition find ample corroboration from the documentary evidence produced on

behalf of the petitioner institution and the affidavit Mr. A. Iqbal Khan, Managing Trustee of Golden Educational and Social Charitable Trust.

- 10. I have perused the Amended Trust Deedof the petitioner institution which was registered before the Sub Registrar, Shivaji Nagaron dated 03.02.2016which is before the filing of NOC applications U/s 10 of the NCMEI Act, 2004 dated 17.09.2019and petition for grant of MSC on dated 27.09.2022. So it is clear that the amendment has been done before the application filed before the State Competent Authority U/s 10 of the NCMEI Act, 2004 and also petition for grant of MSC before this Commission.
- 11. The Amended Trust Deeddated 03.02.2016and all the documents produced by the petitioner institution clearly reflects that the beneficiaries of the petitioner institution are primarily the members of the Muslim minority community. In addition, the said facts also stands proved from the documents and affidavit filed by the petitioner. There is no document on record to rebut the documentary evidence produced on behalf of the petitioner institution.
- 12. Relying on the said unrebutted evidence produced on behalf of the petitioner, we find and hold that Golden Independent Pre-University College, Bagur Sonnenahalli, Lakkur Hobli, Chikkathirupathi Post, Malur Taluk, Kolar Dist., Karnataka 563160run by Golden Educational and Social Charitable Trust is eligible for grant of minority status on religious basis. The evidence also proves that the said educational institution was established with the main objective of sub-serving the interests of the Muslim minority community.
- 13. Consequently, Golden Independent Pre-University College, Bagur Sonnenahalli, Lakkur Hobli, Chikkathirupathi Post, Malur Taluk, Kolar Dist., Karnataka 563160, is declared as an unaided minority educational institution covered under Article 30 of the Constitution of India within the meaning of Section 2(g) of the National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions Act, 2004."
- 14. A minority status certificate be issued accordingly.
- 15. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of in accordance with this order.
