7. It transpires from the petition that the amendment in the Memorandum of Association of the petitioner society was done prior to the filing application u/s 10 of NCMEI Act. 2004 before the State Competent Authority and also petition before this Commission for grant of Minority Status Certificate.
8. It is stated against Col. No. 4(a) of the application that on 28.6.2024 and 11.11.2025, the petitioner institution has applied for grant of No Objection Certificate to the State Competent Authority. The petitioner has not filed application dated 28.6.2024 filed before the State competent authority. Also, the application dated 11.11.2025 is not signed by the petitioner.
9. Office is directed to issue notice to the petitioner to show cause as to why the petition should not be dismissed at this stage.
10. List on 12.03.2026. Record of Case No. 79 of 2025 be tagged with the record of this case.
