During the academic year 2023-24, out of 7621 students, 2594 students were from the Christian Minority Community, in the year 2024-25, out of total 7886 students, 2502 students were from the Christian minority community and in the year 2025-26, out of total 8170 students, 2431 students are from the Christian minority community.

7. It transpires from the petition that Trust Deed of the petitioner Trust was registered prior to the filing application u/s 10 of NCMEI Act. 2004 and also petition before this Commission for grant of Minority Status Certificate.

8. The petitioner has not filed affiliation orders issued by the competent authority with the petition.

9. As per Notice dated 10.5.2024 issued by Commission in F. No. 3-2/2020-NCMEI, the petitioner institution should apply for MSC within nine months from the date of submitting NOC application before the State Competent Authority but the petitioner has applied for grant of minority status certificate before this Commission on 27.01.2026. There is delay in filing the MSC application. Accordingly, the petition is not maintainable.
