By this petition the petitioner has challenged impugned order No. VVM/2019-20/431 dated 05.09.2019 of the respondent no. 4 i.e. Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune.

Vide order No. VVM/2019-20/431 dated 05.09.2019, the Registrar of the respondent no. 4 university directed the petitioners that Rs. 3 lakh per student to be paid for the death of seven students mentioned therein. Society was directed to impose appropriate punishment on the Principal and six teaching and non-teaching staff for committing the recklessness and unpardonable negligence. The punishment shall be executed within 15 days from the receipt of the said order and the action taken report to be submitted to the university.

On 02.12.2019, this matter was registered and subsequently, notices were issued to the respondents.

On 15.07.2022 a reply affidavit of Sh. Sakharam Dattatray Davkhar, Deputy Registrar, Savitribai Phule Pune University (Affiliation Unit) alongwith its annexures received from the learned counsel for the respondent no. 4.

Respondent no. 4 in its affidavit prayed before the Commission to dismiss the aforesaid petition on the ground that the petitioner no. 2 college is affiliated to the respondent university and therefore it is obligatory upon the petitioners to comply with the conditions of affiliation laid down in Section 108 of Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016 right to administer conferred upon the minority educational institutions under Article 30(1) of the Constitution of India does not permit MEIs to mal-administer. Therefore, the decision of the respondent university of imposing penalties upon the petitioners is not violative of the fundamental rights conferred under Article 30(1) of the Constitution of India.

The Joint Director, (Higher Education) Pune, several times requested for the exemption from this case and also sought time to file reply but till date no response received from him.

Vide order dated 15.03.2023 office was directed to issue notice to the Chief Secretary of Maharashtra with the observations that after issuance of notices to the respondents several times, no response has been received from them.

On 23.08.2023, during the course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the Government of Maharashtra has already given compensation to the parents of the deceased students but the amount of compensation is not known.

Vide order dated 23.08.2023, learned counsel for the petitioner and respondent no. 4 wants to file their submissions as to whether the parents of the deceased students are necessary and effective party in this petition or not?

On 31.07.2024, case was proceeded ex-parte against respondent nos. 1 to 3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks time to apprise the Commission about the amount of compensation received by the parents of deceased students from the Government of Maharashtra.

Learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the respondent no. 4 are directed to comply with the order dated 23.08.2023 and file written submissions as to whether the parents of the deceased students are necessary and effective party in this petition or not?
