It is stated in the said letter that "the proposal for making policy guidelines for grant of No Objection Certificate(NOC) to Minority Educational Institutions in Delhi is under process and the file has been put up before the competent authority for approval. Therefore, at this stage "NOC" cannot be issued and request of the school be kept pending till the approval of the same.

A letter dated 9.3.2026 has been received by hand from PA to District Magistrate/ Dy. Commissioner, Distt. (South West) Office Complex, Old Terminal Tax Building, Kapashera, New Delhi along with the letter sent to the District Collector, Kapashera, which is also taken on record. It is stated in the said letter that the petitioner institution comes under the jurisdiction of District Magistrate South, DC South Office Complex, M.B. Road, Saket, New Delhi.

A letter dated 10.3.2026 has been received by hand on 10.3.2026 from Deputy Director of Education (Zone-20), South West-A District, Government of NCT of Delhi, which is also taken on record. It is stated in the said letter that the petitioner institution falls under the jurisdiction of District Magistrate South, DC South Office Complex, M.B. Road, Saket, New Delhi.

It transpires from the record that the petitioner institution has filed an application dated 9.4.2025 before the competent authority of the State Government for No Objection Certificate.

Section 10 of the NCMEI Act, 2004 clearly state that subject to the provisions contained in any other law for the time being in force, any person, who desires to establish a Minority Educational Institution may apply to the competent authority for the grant of No Objection Certificate for the said purpose.

Where within a period of 90 days from the receipt of the application, if the competent authority does not grant NOC or application has been rejected but not communicated to the applicant, it shall be deemed that NOC has been granted and the applicant can file an application for grant of MSC straightaway to this Commission.

The Hon'ble Supreme Court in Civil Appeal No. 3945 of 2018 in case of Sisters of St. Joseph of Cluny vs. The State of West Bengal and Ors. vide order dated 18.04.2018, has held that any person who desires to establish a minority educational institution after the amendment Act of 2006 came into force, must apply only to the competent authority for grant of No Objection Certificate for the said purpose.

All applications for the establishment of a minority educational institution after the amendment Act of 2006 must go to the competent authority set up under the statute.
