A complaint for cancellation of minority status certificate of the respondent institution has been received by post from the complainant on 6.3.2026. It be registered under the Miscellaneous head of cases.

2. The Commission has granted MSC to the respondent institution in Case No. 968 of 2012.

3. It is stated in the complaint that the respondent institution was established and administered by Sri. A. Abdulkhader Ravuthar. The school was not established as a minority institution nor was it intended predominantly for the benefit of Muslim religious minority. Thereafter, the management of the school was devolved upon his son Sri A. Basheer and the same was approved by the AEO for a period of five years from 4.9.2002. Subsequently, on 23.6.2003, Sri A. Abdulkhader Ravuthar passed away. The legal heirs of Sri A. Abdulkhader Ravuthar sold the school to Sri Babu, Ramesh, Abdul Salam and K. Muhammed Haji as per Sale Deed No. 203/2010. It is alleged that the first two buyers were Hindu.

4. Thereafter, the school was sold to Sri Ummer Farooque by virtue of Sale Deed No. 3811/2012 dated 11.12.2012. Meanwhile, by dubious means, Sri Ummer Farooque obtained a minority status certificate from the Commission.

5. Some of the documents annexed with the complaint are in Malayalam language.

6. Summon the complainant to assist the Commission and file English translation of the documents, which are in Malayalam language.
