It transpires from the petition that the amendment in the Memorandum of Association of the petitioner society was done prior to the filing application u/s 10 of the NCMEI Act, 2004 before the State Competent Authority and also petition before this Commission for grant of minority status certificate.

The petitioner has already filed the proof of delivery of track consignment to the respondent.

Petitioner has filed Resolution passed by the Governing Body to obtain minority status certificate from this Commission and envelope with postage for sending notice to the State Competent Authority. He has also filed notarized downloaded copy of affiliation order of the petitioner institution issued by the CBSE from the period 01.04.2026 to 31.03.2031.

It transpires from the petition that the petitioner institution is an unaided institution (Higher Secondary).

During the academic year 2023-24, out of total 529 students, 114 students were from the Jain minority community. In the year 2024-25, out of total 486 students, 96 students were from the Jain minority community and in the year 2025-26, out of 493 students, 41 students were from the Jain minority community.

It transpires from the petition that the amendment in the Memorandum of Association of the petitioner society was done prior to the filing application u/s 10 of the NCMEI Act, 2004 before the State Competent Authority and also petition before this Commission for grant of minority status certificate.

It is stated against column no. 3 of the application that the application for minority status certificate is pending with the State Authority.

Thus there is a glaring inconsistency in the statements made by the petitioner in the application regarding minority status certificate and no objection certificate.

Office is directed to issue notice to the petitioner to show cause as to why the petition should not be dismissed at this stage.
