An application has been received by hand on 06.04.2026 through Mr. Junais P., Advocate for grant of minority status certificate to Holy Child School, Village Chhohan, P.O. Sahle Chak, Tehsil Kalanaur, Chhohan, Gurdaspur District, Punjab – 143 526. It be registered.

It transpires from the petition that on 08.12.2025, the petitioner institution has applied for grant of No Objection Certificate to the State Competent Authority i.e. Branch Director of Public Instruction (S.E.), Punjab Block E, Vidya Bhawan, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor Complex, Punjab School Education Board, Sector – 62, S.A.S. Nagar, Punjab, which was received by the respondent on 12.12.2025. The said application is still pending as per the petitioner institution. The petitioner has waited sufficiently for a period of 90 days as per Section 10 of the NCMEI Act, 2004, before filing this petition. The petitioner has already filed the proof of delivery of track consignment to the respondent.

The petitioner has filed copy of affiliation order dated 24.07.2023 issued by the ICSE.

Petitioner has filed Resolution passed by the Governing Body to obtain minority status certificate from this Commission and envelope with postage for sending notice to the State Competent Authority.

It transpires from the petition that the petitioner institution is an unaided institution (Secondary).

During the academic year 2023-24, out of total 500 students, 114 students were from the Christian minority community. In the year 2024-25, out of total 553 students, 129 students were from the Christian minority community and in the year 2025-26, out of 631 students, 150 students were from the Christian minority community.

It transpires from the petition that the amendment in the Memorandum of Association of the petitioner society was done prior to the filing application u/s 19 of the NCMEI Act, 2004 and also petition before this Commission for grant of minority status certificate.

Office is directed to issue notice to the respondent by registered AD and email. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to file details of students and teachers for the academic year 2026-27.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that physical inspection report received from the Superintendent (Grade-1), for District Collector, Gurdaspur in Case No. 101 of 2025. He further requested that the said report may be considered in the present case. The request of learned counsel for the petitioner is disallowed as the Case No. 101 of 2025 was withdrawn vide order dated 25.11.2025 passed by this Commission.

However, in the facts and circumstances of the case, the Commission deem it just and proper that physical inspection report alongwith the recommendations may be obtained from the Committee constituting of the following members for issuance of the minority status certificate to the petitioner institution:-

1. Representative of the concerned District Collector (Chairperson)
2. Concerned District Education Officer (Member)
3. Concerned District Minority Welfare Officer/ Concerned District Social Welfare Officer (Member Secretary).

Office is directed to issue letter to the above authorities for filing a fresh report in the present case.

Office is also directed to provide copy of the said letter to learned counsel for the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to approach the members of the said committee and provide all the relevant documents to the said committee and pursue the matter with the physical inspection committee for inspection of the petitioner institution.

It transpires from the record that the petitioner institution has not applied for grant of No Objection Certificate before the Competent Authority.

The Hon'ble Supreme Court in Civil Appeal No. 3945 of 2018 in case of Sisters of St. Joseph of Cluny vs. The State of West Bengal and Ors. Vide order dated 18.04.2018, has held that any person who desires to establish a minority education institution after the amendment Act of 2006 came into force, must apply only to the competent authority for grant of No Objection Certificate for the said purpose.

All applications for the establishment of a minority educational institution after the amendment Act of 2006 must go to the competent authority set up under the statute. Hence, this application is not maintainable at this stage.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prayed for time to take instructions from his client. Time prayed for is allowed.
