3. The petitioner has filed notarized Copy of letter dated 15.6.2023 issued by Director of Secondary Education, Assam regarding registering the petitioner institution.

4. Petitioner has filed Resolution Passed by the Governing Body to obtain Minority Status Certificate from this Commission and envelope with postage for sending notice to the State Competent Authority.

5. It also transpires from the petition that the petitioner Institute is an unaided institution (Secondary).

6. During the academic year 2022-23, out of total 1642 students, 90 students were from the Christian minority community, in the academic year 2023-24, out of total 1561 students, 72 students were from the Christian minority community and in the year 2024-25, out of total 1564, 110 students were from the Christian minority community.

7. It transpires from the record that the date mentioned in the declaration part of the MSC application is 14.3.2024 and the petitioner has applied for grant of NOC before the competent authority on 8.12.2025, which is factually incorrect. Hence, the petition is not maintainable.

8. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the petition with liberty to file a fresh petition for the same relief. Leave and liberty is granted. The petition is disposed of as withdrawn.
