ORDER

1. This petition has been received on 31.01.2024 by hand through Mr. Jose Abraham, Advocate of the petitioner institution for grant of Minority Status Certificate (in short 'MSC') to St. Mary's Primary School, Kasbatiwada, Ghogha, Bhavnadar District, Gujarat- 364 110.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner filed an affidavit of Sr. Anna Paul Pamalayil, Secretary of Vedruna Samajik Kendra Society in support of the averments made in the petition and also to prove that the beneficiaries of the petitioner institution are members of the Christian minority community and stating therein that the petitioner institution shall not deny admission of eligible candidate of the Christian minority community subject to the eligibility of the students and availability of the accommodation in the petitioner institution.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has filed notarized copy of Unique ID No. : GJ/2017/0172725 of the petitioner Society as given by the Niti Aayog Portal NGO Darpan, photocopy of application dated 11.10.2023 sent to the State Competent Authority alongwith postal receipt and its tracking report, notarized copies of Certificate of Registration in Gujarati language alongwith its English translation, Memorandum of Association, Rules and Regulations alongwith list of founding members, Amended Memorandum of Association in Gujarati language alongwith its English translation dated 07.09.2023 alongwith list of present members of the Vedruna Samajik Kendra Society, notarized copy of recognition in Gujarati language alongwith its English translation duly notarized by notary public order dated 24.09.2012 issued by the District Education Officer, Bhavnagar granting permission to the unaided petitioner institution and original resolution of the General Body of the Society in favour of Sr. Anna Paul Pamalayil, Secretary of Vedruna Samajik Kendra Society for obtaining MSC from this Commission.
4. As per the information supplied by the petitioner unaided institution with regard to students strength as on Academic Year 2024-25, it is mentioned that out of total 272 students, 137 students were from the Muslim minority community, 04 students were from the Christian minority community and 131 students were Hindu. In the year 2025-26, it is mentioned that out of total 263 students, 132 students were from the Muslim minority community, 04 students were from the Christian minority community and 127 students were Hindu. It is relevant to mention here that during the academic year 2024-25, out of the total 09 teachers, 03 teachers were from the Christian minority community and 06 teachers were

Hindu. In the academic year 2025-26, out of the total 09 teachers, 03 teachers were from the Christian minority community and 06 teachers were Hindu.

5. It is stated in the petition that on dated 11.10.2023, the petitioner institution has applied to the State Competent Authority for grant of NOC which was received by the State Competent Authority on 13.10.2023 and the said application is still pending before the State Competent Authority. The State Competent Authority has not granted NOC in favour of the petitioner institution till now and also not rejected the said application and not communicated the same to the petitioner. After 90 days from the receipt of the application for grant of NOC, the petitioner has filed this petition for grant of MSC to this Commission straightway as per the provisions of Section 10 and 11(f) of National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions (in short 'NCMEI') Act, 2004.
6. After service of registered notice / email dated 15.03.2024, no reply/ response has received from the respondent. Thereafter in the facts and circumstances of the case, Commission deemed fit and proper that physical inspection report alongwith recommendation may be obtained from the Committee constituted by this Commission for issuance of MSC to the petitioner institution vide order dated 24.04.2024. After service of letter/emails to the physical inspection committee dated 10.06.2024 and reminders dated 01.04.2025 and 09.06.2025, Physical inspection committee for sending Physical Inspection Report but the members of the said committee failed to send report to the Commission in terms of order dated 18.03.2025. Hence, the case was proceeded ex-parte against members of the said committee. As per census of India report of 2011 percentage of Christian minority community in the state of Gujarat is 0.52%. As per the information supplied by petitioner institution in the academic year 2025-26, out of the total 263 students, 04 students were from the Christian minority community, which is 1.52% the total student which is more than the state census of 2011 i.e. 0.52%.
7. Heard the Learned Counsel for the petitioner, perused the pleading of the petition, the documents filed by the petitioner and affidavit of Sr. Anna Paul Pamalayil, Secretary of Vedruna Samajik Kendra Society.
8. Hon'ble Apex Court, various High Courts as well as this Commission in case of Buckley Primary School, Cuttack, Orissa Vs. Government of Orissa (order passed by the Commission in Case No. 1320 of 2009 dated 6.7.2010) have categorically held that the percentage of admission of students from notified minority community in a minority educational institution is not an indicia for determining the minority status of such institution. This Commission has also decided that there must be reasonable strength of students of particular minority community in a minority educational institution. The percentage could be determined based on the actual proportion of specific minority community in the State population as per prevailing census. Population of Christian minority community in the State of Gujarat as per the census of 2011 is 0.52%.
9. The petitioner institution has applied for grant of minority status certificate on the ground that the same has been established primarily for the benefit of the members of the Christian minority community and is being administered Vedruna Samajik Kendra Society which is managed and run by the members of the Christian minority community. The aforesaid averments made in the petition find ample corroboration from the documentary evidence produced on behalf of the petitioner institution and the affidavit of Sr. Anna Paul Pamalayil, Secretary of Vedruna Samajik Kendra Society.
10. I have perused the Amended Memorandum of Association of the petitioner institution which was registered before the Public Trust Registration Office, Bhavnagar, on dated 07.09.2023 which is before the filing of NOC applications U/s 10 of the NCMEI Act, 2004 dated 11.10.2023 and petition for grant of MSC on dated 31.01.2024. So it is clear that the amendment has been done before the application filed before the State Competent Authority U/s 10 of the NCMEI Act, 2004 and also petition for grant of MSC before this Commission.

11. The Amended Memorandum of Association dated 07.09.2023 and all the documents produced by the petitioner institution clearly reflects that the beneficiaries of the petitioner institution are primarily the members of the Christian minority community. In addition, the said facts also stands proved from the documents and affidavit filed by the petitioner. There is no document on record to rebut the documentary evidence produced on behalf of the petitioner institution.
12. Relying on the said un rebutted evidence produced on behalf of the petitioner, we find and hold that St. Mary's Primary School, Kasbatiwada, Ghogha, Bhavnadar District, Gujarat- 364 110 run by Vedruna Samajik Kendra Society is eligible for grant of minority status on religious basis. The evidence also proves that the said educational institution was established with the main objective of sub-serving the interests of the Christian minority community.
13. Consequently, St. Mary's Primary School, Kasbatiwada, Ghogha, Bhavnadar District, Gujarat- 364110 is declared as an unaided minority educational institution covered under Article 30 of the Constitution of India within the meaning of Section 2(g) of the National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions Act, 2004".
14. A minority status certificate be issued accordingly.
15. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of in accordance with this order.
