On 19.08.2026, learned counsel for the petitioner filed notarized copy of recognition order of the petitioner institution, which is taken on record. On 18.08.2026, members of the physical inspection committee has sent details of students and teachers of the petitioner institution for the academic year i.e. 2026-27, which is also taken on record.

This petition has been received on 03.04.2024 by hand through Mr. Junais P., Advocate of the petitioner institution for grant of Minority Status Certificate (in short 'MSC') to St. Michael's Prep School, Kamalnath Nagar, Ward No. 23, Bettiah, District West Champaran, Bihar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner filed an affidavits of Mr. Emmanuel Augustine Sharma, Secretary of St. Michael's Educational and Welfare Society and authorized representative of petitioner institution in support of the averments made in the petition and also to prove that the beneficiaries of the petitioner institution are members of the Christian minority community. He has also filed another affidavit stating therein that the petitioner institution shall not deny admission of eligible candidate of the Parsee minority community subject to the eligibility of the students and availability of the accommodation in the petitioner institution.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has filed a notarized copy of Unique ID No.: BR/2023/0355550 of the petitioner's Society as given by the Niti Aayog Portal NGO Darpan, copy of the NOC application dated 14.10.2023 by post to the State Competent Authority alongwith postal receipt and its tracking report, notarized copy of Certificate of Registration, Memorandum of Association, Rules and Regulations, alongwith list of founding and present members of the St. Michael's Educational and Welfare Society, notarized copy of order dated 06.12.2025 issued by the District Education Officer, West Champaran, granting recognition for the period of 05.11.2025 to 05.11.2028 to the unaided petitioner institution and original resolution of the General Body of the Society in favour of Mr. Emmanuel Augustine Sharma, Secretary of St. Michael's Educational and Welfare Society for obtaining MSC from this Commission.

As per the information supplied by the physical inspection committee unaided institution with regard to students' strength, it is mentioned that during the academic year 2023-24, out of the total 654 students, 107 students were from the Muslim minority community, 06 students were from the Christian minority community and 541 students were Hindu. In the academic year 2024-25, out of the total 739 students, 124 students were from the Muslim minority community, 05 students were from the Christian minority community and 610

students were Hindu. In the academic year 2025-26, out of the total 764 students, 136 students were from the Muslim minority community, 04 students were from the Christian minority community and 624 students were Hindu. In the academic year 2026-27, out of the total 776 students, 164 students are from the Muslim minority community, 10 students are from the Christian minority community and 602 students are Hindu. It is relevant to mention here that in the academic year 2023-24, out of 15 teachers, 02 teachers were from the Muslim Minority community, 09 teachers were from the Christian Minority community and 04 teachers were Hindu. In the academic year 2024-25, out of 22 teachers, 03 teachers were from the Muslim Minority community, 10 teachers were from the Christian Minority community and 09 teachers were Hindu. In the academic year 2025-26, out of 24 teachers, 06 teachers were from the Muslim Minority community, 06 teachers were from the Christian Minority community, 02 teachers were from the Sikh minority community and 10 teachers were Hindu. In the academic year 2026-27, out of 25 teachers, 07 teachers are from the Muslim Minority community, 07 teachers are from the Christian Minority community, 01 teacher is from Sikh minority community and 10 teachers are Hindu.

It is stated in the petition that on dated 14.10.2023, the petitioner institution has applied to the State Competent Authority for grant of NOC which was received by the State Competent Authority on 17.10.2023 and the same is still pending before the State Competent Authority. The State Competent Authority has not granted NOC in favour of the petitioner institution till now and also not rejected the said application and not communicated the same to the petitioner. After 90 days from the receipt of the application for grant of NOC, the petitioner has filed this application for grant of MSC to this Commission straightway as per the provisions of Section 10 and 11(f) of National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions (in short 'NCMEI') Act, 2004.

After service of registered notice / email dated 04.06.2024, no reply/response has been received from the respondent. Thereafter in the facts and circumstances of the case, Commission deemed fit and proper that physical inspection report alongwith recommendation may be obtained from the Committee constituted by this Commission for issuance of MSC to the petitioner institution vide order dated 12.12.2024. After service of letter/reminders/emails to the physical inspection committee dated 08.01.2025, 22.03.2025, 23.05.2025, 01.09.2025, 17.10.2025, 22.10.2025, 30.12.2025, 11.03.2026, 18.05.2026, 28.07.2026, original Physical Inspection Report has been received from the District Collector, West Champaran, Bettiah, Bihar, on 11.05.2026 and on 18.08.2026, wherein member of the said committee have not recommended for grant of minority status certificate to the petitioner institution. As per physical inspection report, during the academic year 2026-27, out of 776 students, 10 students are from the Christian minority community, which is 77.6%, which is more than the State census of 2011 i.e. 0.12%.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, perused the pleadings, the documents filed by the petitioner and affidavit of Mr. Emmanuel Augustine Sharma, Secretary of St. Michael's Educational and Welfare Society and authorized representative of petitioner institution.

The petitioner institution has applied for grant of minority status certificate on the ground that the same has been established primarily for the benefit of the members of the Christian minority community and is being administered by St. Michael's Educational and Welfare Society which is managed and run by the members of the Christian minority community. The aforesaid averments made in the petition find ample corroboration from the documentary evidence produced on behalf of the petitioner institution and the affidavit Mr. Emmanuel Augustine Sharma, Secretary of St. Michael's Educational and Welfare Society and authorized representative of petitioner institution.

Hon'ble Apex Court, various High Courts as well as this Commission in case of Buckley Primary School, Cuttack, Orissa Vs. Government of Orissa (order passed by this Commission in Case No. 1320 of 2009 dated 06.07.2010) have categorically held that the percentage of admission of students from notified minority community in a minority educational institution is not an indicia for determining the minority status of such institution. This Commission has also decided that there must be reasonable strength of students of particular minority community in a minority educational institution. The percentage could be determined based on the actual proportion of specific minority community in the State population as per prevailing census. Population of Christian minority community in the State of Bihar as per the census of 2011 is 0.12%.

I have perused the Memorandum of Association of the petitioner society, which was registered before the Inspector General of Registration, Bihar, on dated 11.12.1999, which is before the filing of NOC application U/s 10 of the NCMEI Act, 2004 dated 14.10.2023 and petition for grant of MSC on dated 03.04.2024. So it is clear that the amendment has been done before the application filed before the State Competent Authority U/s 10 of the NCMEI Act, 2004 and also petition for grant of MSC before this Commission.

The Memorandum of Association dated 11.12.1999 of the petitioner society and all the documents produced by the petitioner institution clearly reflect that the beneficiaries of the petitioner institution are primarily the members of the Christian minority community. In addition, the said fact also stands proved from the documents and affidavit filed by the petitioner. There is no document on record to rebut the documentary evidence produced on behalf of the petitioner institution before this Commission.

Relying on the said un rebutted evidence produced on behalf of the petitioner, we find and hold that St. Michael's Prep School, Kamalnath Nagar, Ward No. 23, Bettiah, District West Champaran, Bihar, run by the St. Michael's Educational and Welfare Society is eligible for grant of minority status on religious basis. The evidence also proves that the said educational institution was established with the main objective of sub-serving the interests of the Christian minority community.

Consequently, St. Michael's Prep School, Kamalnath Nagar, Ward No. 23, Bettiah, District West Champaran, Bihar, is declared as unaided minority educational institution covered under Article 30 of the Constitution of India within the meaning of Section 2(g) of the National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions Act, 2004.

A minority status certificate be issued accordingly. Dasti as well.
