G.S.R. 231.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in partial supersession of the Government of India Presses and Branches (Group 'C' and 'D'. Non-Industrial Posts) Recruitment Rules, 2003, the Government of India Presses and Branches in so far as it relates to the Group 'D' posts, except as respects thing done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to Group 'C' (Multi-Tasking Staff Non-Industrial) posts in the Government of India Presses and Branches under the Directorate of Printing, Ministry of Urban Development, namely :—

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Urban Development, Directorate of Printing, Government of India Presses and Branches (Group 'C' Multi-Tasking Staff), Recruitment Rules, 2012.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Application.—These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column (1) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Initial Constitution.—All the persons currently in appointment in the erstwhile Group 'D' posts whose Recruitment Rules are now being superseded on the commencement of these rules are automatically deemed to have been appointed under these rules against permanent or temporary posts mentioned in these rules.

4. Number of posts, classification and pay band, grade pay and pay scale.—The number of said posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto, shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) and annexure of the said Schedule.

5. Method of recruitment, age-limit educational qualifications, etc.—The method of recruitment, age-limit, educational qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

6. Disqualification. —No person,—

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts :

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

7. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

8. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Upper age-limit is also relaxable for the Scheduled castes, Scheduled Tribes, Ex-servicemen and other categories of person in accordance with the instructions or orders issued by the Central Government from time to time.
