Minutes of Meeting of the Project Implementation Committee held on 13/05/2022.

A meeting of the Project Implementation Committee (PIC) was held on 13/05/2022 in the chamber of the Hon. Secretary, Financial Reforms, Department of Finance, Mantralaya, Mumbai. The list of participants are as follows: -

The agendas for the meeting of the PIC were as follows: -

- 1. PIC proposal for minor modification in MoM of 146th HPC.
- 2. Selection of System Integrator (SI) for development of APIs for GST data consumption.
- Selection of new PMC for MGSTD for the period from 01st June 2022 to 31st May 2023.

The agenda items were discussed, and decisions were taken as follows: -

Agenda no.1

PIC proposal for minor modification in MoM of 146th HPC.

Discussion:

It is informed that,

- MGSTD had submitted proposal to 146th HPC for approval of bid of M/s. Orient Technologies Pvt Ltd at cost of Rs.51,73, 85,634/- and GST as applicable as L1 bid and to authorize MGSTD to issue the work order to the said L1 bidder. The same was approved by 146th HPC and MOM were issued accordingly.
- Department had submitted written proposal to 146th HPC, which was taken up in the meeting. There was a detailed discussion in the HPC meeting on the proposal and the decision was taken to issue work order to L1 bidder. However, on perusal of minutes, it is seen that deliberations during the HPC meeting were not properly reflected in MOM. Hence, it is felt that there is need for minor modifications in minutes without having any bearing on the final decision of HPC.
- Accordingly, proposal was submitted to 151st HPC to approve minor modifications in MOM of 146th HPC.

In 151st HPC meeting, HPC directed that the proposed modifications in MoM may be submitted for the perusal and review of PIC and then submit to HPC for approval.

Proposal for consideration-

"HPC noted the details in the proposal that the UPS provisioned by L1 bidder is of insufficient quantity and that the L1 bidder has submitted an undertaking to MGSTD assuring supply of the required UPS at no additional cost to department. The MGSTD submitted that as per the consulting firm for the department EY, the specifications of the products proposed by L1 bidder have been checked and are found to be as per the RFP. The department further submitted that the RFP did not specify numbers of components to be deployed and that the efficacy of the system will be ensured through Service Levels defined in the RFP. ACS (Revenue) suggested that proper monitoring of SLA parameters should be done by the department to take necessary penal actions as and when required. HPC approved the proposal subject to the above conditions."

Decision:

PIC considered the proposal and recommended to HPC for the minor modifications in MOM of 146th HPC as follows:

"HPC noted the details in the proposal that the UPS provisioned by L1 bidder is of insufficient quantity and that the L1 bidder has submitted an undertaking to MGSTD assuring supply of the required UPS at no additional cost to department. The MGSTD submitted that as per the consulting firm for the department EY, the specifications of the products proposed by L1 bidder have been checked and are found to be as per the RFP. The department further submitted that the RFP did not specify numbers of components to be deployed and that the efficacy of the system will be ensured through Service Levels defined in the RFP. ACS (Revenue) suggested that proper monitoring of SLA parameters should be done by the department to take necessary penal actions as and when required. HPC approved the proposal subject to the above conditions."

Agenda no. 2

Selection of System Integrator (SI) for development of APIs for GST data consumption.

Discussion:

It is informed that in the 61st PIC meeting dated 06th Dec 2021, following agenda was approved.

- 1. PIC had granted Administrative & Financial approval for:
 - a. Selection of NICSI empanelled System Integrator (SI) for development and maintenance of APIs for Rs.1,12,50,000/- and applicable taxes thereon.
 - b. Cost of infrastructure required at Rs.10,00,000/- and applicable taxes thereon.
 - c. Pay-out to be made to NICSI on milestone basis as per NICSI norms.
- 2. PIC authorized Commissioner of State Tax to set up a Committee, as required, for selection of the agency.

Thus, in line with the above decision, the MGSTD floated a limited tender on 24th February 2022, and it was shared with all the NICSI empaneled agencies. Further a committee was also formed by the Commissioner of State Tax under the chairmanship of Joint Commissioner of State Tax (INV-A) for the selection of the agency.

3. The department received three technical proposals from the following NICSI empanelled agencies out of which two were technically qualified.

Note: The RFP had a TQ cut-off of 30 / 50 marks

- 4. The committee found M/s. ABM Knowledgeware Ltd. is the L1 bidder with the proposed cost of Rs.1,49,55,823/-. The L1 bidder on request of the committee submitted revised proposal as Rs.1,42,00,000/-. It is noticed by the committee that the revised proposal is above 26.22 % of the estimated cost.
- 5. As per the provisions of the Industry GR dated 1st December 2016, section 4.4.3.1 (b) "If two tenders become technically qualified, the actual purchase price and the estimated price decided earlier has a difference of (-) 20 % to (+) 10 %, the purchasing department has liberty to accept the same. If such price do not come under the price band then there should be re-tender." Hence, the Committee rejected the proposal of the L1 bidder since it was more than 10% above the estimated cost.
- 6. Reason for change of proposed mode of procurement:

- i. In view of the limited participation of the bidders in the RFP (only three bidders participated in the RFP) it will not be prudent to again go for a limited tender for NICSI empanelled vendors.
- ii. Hence, it is proposed that the Selection of System Integrator (SI) for development of APIs for GST data consumption be done via open tender at the earlier approved cost. All other terms of the project i.e., timelines, SLAs, scope of work would largely remain the same. The terms of the RFP will be approved by the Commissioner of State Tax.
- iii. The infrastructure needed for hosting this project till cloud migration of EIU is proposed to be procured from Coforge by a Change Request.

Proposal for consideration-

- 1. PIC may accord Administrative and financial approval for
 - i. Selection of System Integrator (SI) for development and maintenance of APIs through an Open tender for Rs 1,12,50,000/- and applicable taxes thereon,
 - ii. Cost of infrastructure required at Rs. 10, 00,000/- and applicable taxes thereon.
- 2. The terms of the RFP will be approved by the Commissioner of State Tax.
- 3. Commissioner of State Tax may be authorized to set up a Committee for selection of the SI.

Decision:

- 1. PIC granted Administrative and financial approval for
 - Selection of System Integrator (SI) for development and maintenance of APIs through an Open tender for Rs 1,12,50,000/- and applicable taxes thereon,
 - ii. Cost of infrastructure required at Rs. 10,00,000/- and applicable taxes thereon.
- 2. The terms of the RFP will be approved by the Commissioner of State Tax.
- 3. PIC authorized Commissioner of State Tax to set up a Committee, as required for selection of the System Integrator.

Agenda no. 3

Selection of new PMC for MGSTD for the period from 01st June 2022 to 31st May 2023.

Discussion:

It is informed that,

- PIC meeting held on 15th Mar 2021 had selected M/s. Ernst & Young LLP as PMC for the automation project of Maharashtra Goods & Service Tax Department (MGSTD) as per DIT(MH) GR dtd.09th May 2019, for the period of 12 months from 01st Apr 2021 to 31st Mar 2022. The contract period ended on 31st Mar 2022. MGSTD needed continuous support of PMC for the further period from Apr 2022 onwards.
- Accordingly, as per clause no.5 of DIT (MH) GR dtd.09.05.2019, the department initiated the process for selection of new PMC. However, the whole process of selection and onboarding of new PMC may consume more time even after expiry of existing contract i:e 31st Mar 2022. Hence, MGSTD vide proposal no. CST/ Mahavikas /2021-22/ PIC / Extension of PMC/B-1952, Mumbai, dtd.03.03.2022 requested PIC for extension of existing PMC i:e E&Y on urgent requirement basis for 2 months period from 01st Apr 2022 to 31st May 2022 as per clause no.6 of DIT(MH) GR dtd.09.05.2019.
- Accordingly, PIC meeting held on 08.04.2022 has approved the proposal and granted Administrative & Financial approval for extension of existing PMC for the period of 2 months from 01.04.2022 to 31.05.2022.
- MGSTD Department will require support of PMC for further period from 01st June 2022 onwards for defined scope of work.
- The clause no.5 of DIT (MH) GR dtd.09.05.2019 provides procedure related to selection of project management consultancy as under:-

"Clause 5:- Selection of the consultancy firm: Any department of Govt. of Maharashtra may appoint any of the empanelled consultants for governance related work in the state at the rates mentioned in this GR.

For selection of consultant on *Man-Month basis through this empanelment GR, following should be followed.

- 1. Departments need to finalize the scope of work for consultancy with concurrence of DIT.
- 2. Thereafter departments should circulate the scope of work among empanelled firms and call for presentation with the CVs (Format of CV provided in Annexure 3) of the proposed resources before their Project Implementation Committee (PIC). The notice for the same should be sent at least 1 week in advance.
- 3. The consulting empanelled firms need to clearly define the milestones in their proposal for the project.

4. Based on the presentation, the firm's understanding of the project output and quality of resources proposed, the PIC may select consultants based on their requirement.

- On 19th Mar 2021, GoM has issued a corrigendum to the above GR. As per this corrigendum, approval of Scope of work is revised as under: "Clause 5.1: Departments need to finalize the Scope of work for consultancy with concurrence of ACS/PS/ Secretary of concerned Department".
- Accordingly, MGSTD department has finalized requirement of resources and their scope of work to be done during the contract period.
- Details of Scope of Work, requirement of resources, type of resource and cost involved for engagement of new PMC for automation project of MGSTD department is as under:-

In view of the above, proposal was submitted for consideration of PIC, seeking Administrative and Financial approval for Selection and onboarding of new PMC as per DIT GR dtd.09.05.2019 for period of 12 months from 01st Jun 2022 to 31st May 2023 for the cost of Rs.2,25,12,600/- and applicable taxes there on.

- MGSTD has issued LOI (Letter Of Invitation) vide proposal no. MGSTD/Mahavikas/Selection/PMC_22-23/B-1910, dated 19.04.2022 for communication to all DIT empanelled consultancy firms to invite their proposals to provide the consultancy services for the automation project of MGSTD department.
- Accordingly, PIC meeting was scheduled on 13th May 2022 for selection of PMC for MGSTD automation project. In the meeting, out of DIT empanelled firms M/s. Ernst & Young attended and submitted the proposal along with resumes of the resources proposed for the project and made presentation before PIC members. The details of observation on resources proposed and presented by PMC are as under:

 It was observed that 5 out of the 7 proposed resources by M/s EY were new to the project. So, M/s. EY agreed to provide the services of Mr.Abhishek Chavan (Sr. Manager) for a period of 3 months to ensure a smooth knowledge transfer without putting additional financial burden on MGSTD. **Decision of the PIC Committee:**

- 1. PIC selected M/s. Ernst & Young LLP as a Project Management Consultancy agency for the period of 12 months from 01.06.2022 to 31.05.2023 for MGSTD.
- 2. PIC has also directed MGSTD to verify the credentials (educational qualifications, experience etc.) of these consultants from the original documents before getting them joined in the Department.
- 3. PIC granted Administrative and Financial approval for Rs.2,25,12,600/-and applicable taxes thereon for the period from 01.06.2022 to 31.05.2023 as per Table no.1.
