Greetings from National Law University Delhi!

I am writing to you on behalf of National Law University Delhi (NLU) as a regional coordinator for **All India Law Entrance Test (AILET) – 2021** across the country. NLU is a premier Law University established in capital city of India. We conduct AILET for admission to B.A.LL.B.(Hons.), LL.M and Ph.D . Programmes each year.

Sir, as you would be aware, the AILET is a reputed law entrance examination in India and an essential requirement for any student desirous of studying law – at the undergraduate or postgraduate level – the National Law University Delhi. Several other state and private Universities also use the AILET score as the basis of admission. As such, the conduct of the AILET in a timely manner is critical in ensuring students do not lose all or a significant portion of their academic year, and the NLU Delhi has made all possible efforts to avoid this possibility.

The AILET was initially scheduled for June 20, 2021. However, in light of the second wave of COVID-19 pandemic, and the subsequent lockdown restrictions forced to reschedule the AILET 2021 to Friday, July 30, 2021.

Further, the NLU Delhi has ensured that preparations for the AILET 2021 are in strict compliance with the highest standards of protocols and as detailed by the **All India Institute of Medical Sciences** for its entrance exam. So we have ensured sanitization and fumigation of centre premises, strict physical distancing during entry and exit and during the exam as well as separate isolation facilities for those students who may be symptomatic. Further, the Consortium will set aside a Medical Contingency Fund, to mitigate any damages caused by any unforeseen events.

Sir, at this juncture, we request your assistance for smooth conduct of AILET on Friday, July 30, 2021 as planned, so as to ensure that 20,000 candidates who have registered for the examination do not face the prospect of losing an entire academic year. - The AILET-2021 be identified as an Essential Activity;
- The examination centres across the state may be allowed to open and operate for all activities related to the preparation and conduct of the AILET 2021, to be held on Friday, July 30, 2021;
- The candidates with their Admit Card of AILET 2021 may be considered as an equivalent of a curfew pass for movement for the purpose of the AILET-2021 on Friday, July 30, 2021;
- The movement of candidates to and from their home and the examination centres may be facilitated;
- The support staff and observers of the AILET- 2021 and its Vendors and Partners may be permitted to travel for the purposes of preparation and conduct of the AILET-2021 from one day prior to one day after the date of the examination, i.e., July 30, 2021; and
- Local authorities may be authorised to provide the necessary administrative facilitation and security for the conduct of the AILET 2021 on July 30, 2021.

Sir, your intervention at this juncture would help ensure the preservation of the academic aspirations of the AILET 2021 candidates, and the conduct of this national examination of vital importance. The undersigned will be available at all times to respond to any queries or clarifications you may have in this regard.
