The total number of 150 participants including Secretaries/officials from Department of Women and Child Development of States, DGPs, State Human Right Commission and State Commission for Protection of Child Rights attended the said conference.



It is notable that National Human Rights Commission was deeply concerned related to the violation of Child rights in the country. With the view to review the implementation of these Acts related to children, the commission is organizing Regional Review Conferences on JJ Act 2015 and POCSO Act 2012 in different parts of the country. In the year 2017, the Commission had organised the Regional Conferences at Chennai (Tamil Nadu covering the southern States and at Imphal (Manipur) covering all the north-eastern States.
