Every year, the Ministry of Women and Child Development, Government of India, organizes 'Hausla', a programme to celebrate the outstanding skills and talent of children residing in Child Care Institutions of India.

This year, Haryana State Child Protection Society organized State Level Hausla-2019 on 11.12.2019 at Rajiv Gandhi Khel Stadium Rohtak. It is notable that about 250 children residing in the Children Homes from all across the districts of Haryana participated in the said event for various sports and cultural activities.

Mr. R S Verma, the Deputy Commissioner of Rohtak, graced the celebrations with his presence as Chief Guest for the event. The event was also attended by Mr. Rakesh Khatri, CJM DALSA, who graced the occasion as 'Special Guest' and distributed awards to the winners.

Several activities were hosted for the Children residing in the CCIs Haryana to provide space to the children to express their creative, academic and physical abilities. **The central idea behind this initiative is to bring the children living in CCIs to the mainstream of the society.** Among the various categories (separate for boys and girls above the age of 14 years), the prominent activities that were conducted included athletics events( 100 meter races, long jump, high jump), painting competition, speech competition, discussion and Chess.
