DETAILED NOTICE INVITING SHORT TERM e TENDER FOR PURCHASE OF MOBILE PHONES UNDER Poshan Abhiyan (ICDS).

Women and Child development department invites e tender for the purchase mobile phones at district head quarters of W & CD Department (Haryana) Under two bid systems from the eligible Partnership / Proprietorship/Private limited Firms. Under this process the technical bid as well as price bid shall be invited at single stage that under two bids that is technical bid & financial bid. Eligibility of bidders will be first examined on the basis of details submitted online under technical bid with respect to eligibility and qualification criteria prescribed in the tender document. The financial bid of only eligible bidders shall be opened.

1. The payment for Tender Document Fee shall be made by eligible bidders online directly through Internet Banking Accounts and e-Service Fee through Debit Cards & Internet Banking Accounts. The payment for EMD can be made online directly through RTGS/NEFT or OTC Please refer to 'Online Payment Guideline' available at the Single e-Procurement portal of GoH (Govt. of Haryana) and also mentioned under the Tender Document.
2. Intending bidders will be mandatorily required to Online Sign-up (create user account) on the website <https://haryanaeprocurement.gov.in> to be eligible to participate in the e-Tender. **He/She will be required to make online payment towards EMD fee in due course of time. The intended bidder fails to pay EMD fee under the stipulated time frame shall not be allow to submit his / her bids for the respective event / Tenders.**
3. The interested parties bidders must remit the funds as per schedule given under key dates and make payment via online directly through debit cards & internet banking accounts to the beneficiary account number.
4. The intended parties thereafter will be able to successfully verify their payment online and submit their bids on or before the expiry date and time of the respective event / tender at <https://haryanaeprocurement.gov.in>
5. The interested parties / bidders shall have to pay mandatorily e service fee (Under document fee/ non refundable) of Rs : 1000/- (One thousand rupees only) online by using the service of secure electronic gateway . The secured electronic payments gateway is online interface between bidders & online payment Authorization network.
6. The payment for each tender fee (Rs : 5000/-) (exempted for MSME) & E service fee (1000/ -) Can be made by eligible parties online directly through debit card & internet banking.

8. The selected bidders will have to submit a performance guarantee of amount equivalent to 2% of the financial Bid.

2. Obtaining a Digital Certificate:

2.1 The Bids submitted online should be encrypted and signed electronically with a Digital Certificate to establish the identity of the party/bidder bidding online. These Digital certificates are issued by an Approved Certifying Authority, by the Controller of Certifying Authorities, Government of India.

2.2 A Digital Certificate is issued upon receipt of mandatory identity (i.e. Applicant's PAN Card) and Address proofs and verification form duly attested by the Bank Manager / Post Master / Gazetted Officer. 2.5 Bid for a particular tender must be submitted online using the digital certificate (Encryption Signing), which is used to encrypt and sign the data during the stage of bid preparation. In case, during the process of a particular tender, the user loses his digital certificate (due to virus attack, hardware problem, operating system or any other problem) he will not be able to submit the bid online. Hence, the users are advised **to keep a backup of the certificate** and also keep the copies at safe place under proper security (for its use in case of emergencies).

2.6 In case of online tendering, if the digital certificate issued to the authorized user of a firm issued for signing and submitting a bid, it will be considered equivalent to a no-objection certificate/power of attorney /lawful authorization to that User. The firm has to authorize a specific individual through an authorization certificate signed by all partners to use the digital certificate as per Indian Information Technology Act 2000. Unless the certificates are revoked, it will be assumed to represent adequate authority of the user to bid on behalf of the firm in the Page 5 of 12 department tenders as per Information Technology Act 2000. The digital signature of this authorized user will be binding on the said firm.

2.7 In case of any change in the authorization, it shall be the responsibility of management/partners of the firm to inform the certifying authority about the change and to obtain the digital signature of the new person / user on behalf of the manufacture firm. The procedure for application of a digital certificate however will remain the same for the new user.

2.8 The same procedure holds true for the authorized users in a private firm /Public limited Company. In this case, the authorization certificate will have to be signed by the directors of the manufacture firm.

3. Opening of an Electronic Payment Account:

For purchasing the tender document online, parties/bidders are required to pay the tender document fee online using the electronic payments gateway service. For online payments guidelines, please refer to the Home page of the e-tendering Portal <https://haryanaeprocurement.gov.in>.

4. Pre-requisites for online bidding:

In order to operate on the electronic tender management system, a user's machine is required to be set up. A help file on system setup/Pre-requisite can be obtained from Nextenders (India) Pvt. 7. Schedule/Key Dates:

The bidders are strictly advised to follow dates and times as indicated in the online Notice Inviting Tenders. The date and time shall be binding on all parties/bidders. All online activities are time tracked and the system enforces time locks that ensure that no activity or transaction can take place outside the start and end dates and the time of the stage as defined in the online Notice Inviting Tenders.

8. Online Payment of Tender Document Fee, e-Service fee & Bid preparation & Submission (Technical & Financial/Price Bid):

8.1 Online Payment of Tender Document Fee + e-Service fee: The online payment for Tender document fee, e-Service Fee can be done using the secure electronic payment gateway. The Payment for Tender Document Fee and eService Fee shall be made by parties/bidders/Vendors online directly through Debit Cards & Internet Banking Accounts the secure electronic payments gateway is an online interface between contractors and Debit card / online payment authorization networks.

8.2 PREPARATION & SUBMISSION OF ONLINE APPLICATIONS/BIDS:

- (i) Detailed Tender documents may be downloaded from e-procurement website (<https://haryanaeprocurement.gov.in>) and tender must be submitted online following the instruction appearing on the screen.
- (ii) Scanned copy of Document is to be submitted/uploaded for Technical bid under online Technical Bid/Envelope. The required documents (refer to DNIT) shall be prepared and scanned in different file formats (in PDF/JPEG/MS WORD format such that file size not exceed more than 10 MB) and uploaded during the on-line submission of Technical Bid/Envelope.

A. Only Electronic Form (Refer Tender document).

FINANCIAL/ PRICE BID shall be submitted through online mode only under Financial Envelope/Bid and not to be submitted manually.

NOTE:-Manufacture firm as bidders participating in online tenders shall check the validity of his/her Digital Signature Certificate before participating in the online Tenders at the portal <https://haryanaeprocurement.gov.in>.

In the first instance, the online payment details of tender document fee + e-Service & Technical Envelope shall be opened. Henceforth, online financial bid of the shortlisted bidder/party/Agency shall be opened in the presence of such parties/bidders/Agency who either themselves or through their representatives choose to be present.

The bidder can submit their online bids as per the dates mentioned in the schedule/Key Dates above.

Guidelines for Online Payments at e-Procurement Portal of Government of Haryana.

Post registration, Party/bidder shall proceed for bidding by using both his digital certificates(one each for encryption and signing) & Password. Bidder/Party shall proceed to select the event/Tenders he is interested in. On the respective Department's page in the e-Procurement portal, the Bidder would have following options to make payment for tender document fee:

A. Debit Card

B. Net Banking

Operative Procedures for Bidder Payments

A) Debit Card

The procedure for paying through Debit Card will be as follows:

- (i) Bidder selects Debit Card option in e-Procurement portal.
- (ii) The e-Procurement portal displays the amount and the card charges to be paid by bidder. The portal also displays the total amount to be paid by the bidder.
- (iii) Bidder clicks on "Continue" button
- (iv) The e-Procurement portal takes the bidder to Debit Card payment gateway screen.
- (v) Bidder enters card credentials and confirms payment.
- (vi) The gateway verifies the credentials and confirms with "successful" or "failure" message, which is confirmed back to e-Procurement portal.
- (vii) The page is automatically routed back to e-Procurement portal.
- (viii) The status of the payment is displayed as "successful" in e-Procurement portal. The e-Procurement portal also generates a receipt for all successful transactions. The bidder can take a print out of the same,
- (ix) The e-Procurement portal allows Bidder to process another payment attempt in case payments are not successful for previous attempt.

B) Net Banking

The procedure for paying through Net Banking will be as follows:

- (i) Bidder selects Net Banking option in e-Procurement portal.
- (ii) The e-Procurement portal displays the amount to be paid by bidder.
- (iii) Bidder clicks on "Continue" button.
- (iv) The e-Procurement portal takes the bidder to Net Banking payment gateway screen displaying list of Banks.
- (v) Bidder chooses his / her Bank.

- (vi) The Net Banking gateway redirects Bidder to the Net Banking page of the selected Bank.
- (vii) Bidder enters his account credentials and confirms payment.
- (viii) The Bank verifies the credentials and confirms with “successful” or “failure” message to the Net Banking gateway which is confirmed back to e-Procurement portal.
- (ix) The page is automatically routed back to e-Procurement portal.
- (x) The status of the payment is displayed as “successful” in e-Procurement portal. The e-Procurement portal also generates a receipt for all successful transactions. The bidder can take a print out of the same.
- (xi) The e-Procurement portal allows Bidder to process another payment attempt in case payments are not successful for previous attempt.

C) RTGS/ NEFT

The bidder shall have the option to make the EMD payment via RTGS/ NEFT/OTC. Using this module, bidder would be able to pay from their existing Bank account through RTGS/NEFT. This would offer a wide reach for more than 90,000 bank branches and would enable the bidder to make the payment from almost any bank branch across India.

- i. Bidder shall log into the client e-procurement portal using user id and password as per existing process and selects the RTGS/NEFT payment option.
- ii. Upon doing so, the e-procurement portal shall generate a pre-filled challan. The challan will have all the details that is required by the bidder to make RTGS-NEFT payment.
- iii. Each challan shall therefore include the following details that will be pre-populated:

- iv. The Bidder shall be required to take a print of this challan and make the RTGS/NEFT on the basis of the details printed on the challan.
- v. The bidder would remit the funds at least T + 1 day (Transaction + One day) in advance to the last day and make the payment via RTGS / NEFT to the beneficiary account number as mentioned in the challan.

- vi. Post making the payment, the bidder would login to the e-Tendering portal and go to the payment page. On clicking the RTGS / NEFT mode of payment, there would be a link for real time validation. On clicking the same, system would do auto validation of the payment made.

Standard Terms and Conditions (wherever applicable these terms & conditions will overrule the specific terms and conditions):-

1. EMD:- The firms are required to deposit Earnest Money as indicated above failing which the tenders are liable to be rejected. Manufacturing Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) of the State, Central or Haryana Public Sector Enterprises and “approved sources” as declared by the Industries Department, Haryana, are exempt from the deposit of EMD. As per Haryana State E-procurement System policy.
2. Performance Security: The successful tenderer shall be required to deposit Performance Security Deposit as per provisions contained in Govt. of Haryana G.O. No. 2/2/2016-4I BII(2) dated 20-10-2016 as under:-

Haryana based MSEs will be eligible for performance security deposit @ 0.2% who have filed Entrepreneurs Memorandum (Micro or Small Enterprise category) in the Industries Department Haryana and who participate directly in the tendered/quoted items and offering to supply the entire quoted quantity manufactured from their own Haryana based unit.

The performance security in excess of the EMD already deposited can be submitted in the shape of Demand Draft/Call Deposit Receipt/Banker’s Cheque or in the shape of equivalent Bank Guarantee of any scheduled bank with branch in Chandigarh/ Panchkula.

3. The bidders are required to quote the basic rates, the delivery/ transportation costs/ applicable GST and duties etc, and the place of billing for the supply of stores clearly and separately. The bidders are required to intimate the place of billing.
4. Penalty Clause for Department/ Govt. Agencies for delay in Payment Delay in payments to the suppliers beyond the stipulated credit period indicated in the supply order, unless supported by cogent reasons and approved by a higher authority, will attract penal interest on the defaulting amount @ Rs. 25/- per rupees one lakh per day of delay beyond the stipulated credit period. Non provision of adequate budget will be no ground for delay in payments to the supplier. This is as per provisions contained at Para 17 of G.O. 5. Negotiation of Rates Regarding negotiations of rates, policy issued by the State Government vide G.O. No.2/2/2010-4-IB-II dated 18.06.2013 (Annexure-VI), G.O. No.2/2/2010-4-IB-II dated 16.06.2014 (Annexure-VII), G.O. No.2/2/2010-4-IB-II dated 09.02.2015 (Annexure-VIII) will be applicable. 6. Concession to MSMEs of State: State Government “Haryana State Public Procurement Policy for MSME -2016” issued vide G.O. No. 2/2/2016-4I BII(1) dated 20-10-2016 (Annexure-IX) and G.O. No. 2/3/2018-4IB-II dated 23.04.2018 (Annexure-X) will be applicable in respect of concessions to Haryana based MSMEs and KVIs. For claiming the relevant concession/s like Tender Fee, Earnest Money Deposit (EMD), Turnover, Exemption in respect of Past Performance & Experience, Purchase Preference and Performance Security, the bidders are required to submit the documentary proof from Government authorities showing that they come under Haryana based manufacturing MSME/KVI units as the case may be e.g. *Entrepreneurs Memoranda in Haryana in bidder’s name and further subject to fulfillment of eligibility criteria as provided in the said Policy of 2016. *Note:- To claim the concessions/benefits under the above policy, the bidder is required to submit Manufacturing Entrepreneurs Memorandum issued by the Industries Department Haryana in respect of the quoted item or Udhog Aadhaar Memorandum (UAM) of Haryana based manufacturing enterprises in respect of the quoted item (Ref. Industries & Commerce Department Haryana Memo No.TS/DS&D/11389-A Dated 03.07.2018) and further subject to fulfillment of eligibility criteria as provided in the said Policy of 2016.
7. In case of evidence of cartel formation by the bidder(s), the EMD is liable to be forfeited along with other actions as are permissible to Government like filing complaints with the Competition Commission of India and/ or other appropriate forums.
8. Purchase Preferences for approved Sources The Director, Supplies & Disposals, Haryana, reserves the right to allow purchase preference to the approved sources, including Central or Haryana State Public Sector Undertakings/Enterprises, provided that such approved source takes part in the bidding process and the quoted prices of the approved source is within 10% of the lowest acceptable price, other things being equal. However, such purchase preference would be available to the approved source only at the lowest acceptable price. The latest list of Approved Source is contained in Government Order no. 6/03/2007-4IB-II dated: 14-02-2008 of the Industries Department and is subject to further amendment from time to time.
9. Penalty clause for rejected samples/ material offered by the Bidder: In case, the material offered for inspection by the firm fails to meet the specifications stipulated in NIT/Order/Contract and the samples are rejected by the Inspecting Committee, the Indenting Department will have the right to levy a penalty at 0.1% of the total order value. In case, the material offered for inspection fails during the 2nd inspection also, the Indenting Department will have the right to increase the penalty to 0.25% of the total order value. In case, the material offered fails during the 3rd and final inspection also, the firm will be liable for penal action including forfeiture of security, risk purchase, debarring/blacklisting in future, and no further opportunity for inspection would be provided to the supplier firm.
10.
