TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Note 1: Qualification:-

1. Applicant should be actively involved in health, education or welfare activities pertaining to children for at least 7 years.

Or

Practicing professional with a degree in Child Psychology or Psychiatry or Law or Social work or Sociology or Human Development.

2. The applicant shall not be less than 21 years of age at the date of inviting the application.

Note 2: Tenure of CWC Chairperson/Members.

The tenure of Chairperson/ Member is for a period of one year which may be extended on year to year basis subject to maximum tenure of three years.

Note 3: Honorarium of CWC Chairperson/Members.

The member of the Committee shall be paid travelling/meeting allowance of Rs. 1000/- (Rs. One thousand only) per sitting/meeting.

Note 4: The applicant must be a **resident of Haryana** as the nature of job responsibility requires presence at the place of posting even at odd hours or on short notice.

Note 5: The applicant shall have to submit a self-declaration/affidavit on the following points:-

- (a) He has no previous conviction record.
- (b) He has not been involved in any immoral act or in the Act of child abuse or employment of child labour.
- (c) He is not holding such other full time occupation that does not allow him to give necessary time and attention to the work of the Committee.
- (d) No enquiry is pending against him/her in any agency/court.

Note 6: Applicants who are interested to apply for both the posts should submit their applications separately. Applicants who are eligible should submit their applications along-with Bio-Data with their duly attested certificates of educational qualifications and experience to the concerned District Programme Officer-Women & Child Development of the District in prescribed format upto 25-04-2016.

Note 7: The selected candidate will have to undergo police verification and medical test. They are strictly required to maintain Headquarter at the posting station. Appointment will be cancelled if Headquarter is not maintained.

Note 8: The selected candidate is governed by the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015 and Rules to be framed under the Act.
