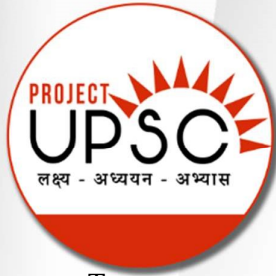

Shift- 1	5.	Options for answer marked 5, 6, 7, 8 whereas options for correct answer given as 1, 2, 3, 4	There is a minor typing error due to format change of question paper. This error doesn't exist in the PDF format we provided, but in Word file, due to automatic formatting by the Microsoft Word, this change happened. But the question and options are clear enough for graduate students to understand and answer the question. So, no grace marks will be given for this question.
	47.	"AXE" printed instead of "ARE"	There is a minor typing error wherein 'are' has been written as 'axe', but the question and options are clear enough for graduate students to understand and answer the question. So, no grace marks will be given for this question.
	18, 19 & 61, 62	Same question repeated	Q61 and Q62 are same as Q18 and Q19 respectively. There is no error and marks have been provided to correct answers. So, no grace marks will be given for this question.

	91.	<b>There is a typing error, wherein '10^10' has been written as '1010'. Grace marks will be provided for this question.</b>
	98.	This question was previously asked in the UPSC Civil Services Exam (Prelims) General Studies Official Paper-II CSAT (Held On: 28th May 2023). So, there is no error and no grace marks will be provided.
	99.	<b>There is a typing error, wherein '?' has been written as '7'. So, grace marks will be provided for this question.</b>

The ambiguity against the above mentioned questions have been resolved from our end and the marking with the grace marks will be updated after your response is received.
