Appellant - Present

Heard the learned counsel on the point of condonation of delay of about eight years in preferring the instant appeal. The learned counsel submitted that as the appellant went to foreign country for advance study, he could not purchase the arms during the stipulated period. He further submitted that the delay caused in filing the appeal was mainly due to some unavoidable circumstances as such delay may be condoned and this appeal petition may be admitted.

In view of the aforesaid position, I do not find any substantial merit in the claim forwarded by the learned counsel for the appellant. In fact there is inordinate delay of about eight years in filing the appeal and even the reasons explained for such delay is not reasonable one as well as not satisfactory also.

As such I am not inclined to condon the delay of eight years.

Accordingly this appeal petition is dismissed at the admission stage on the ground of inordinate delay in preferring the appeal.
