**ORDER**

The instant appeal application is directed against the impugned order of M. Saran passed in Aanganbari case No. 43/2011 on 23.12.2011

Heard.

The learned counsel for the appellant submits that the petitioner is a Panchayat functionary of Gram Panchayat Kishunpur Lower of Lahladpur, Block and is dissatisfied with the preparation of mapping register for the selection of Aanganbari Sevika and subsequent selection made on that basis. As such he approached the authorities for rectification of the same.

The learned G.P. submits that the present appellant has no locus standi in the matter as he is not an affected party in the case, so the case is not maintainable before this Court.

Considering the facts and circumstance of the case, and on going through the records I also find that the issue brought before this Court, obviously falls outside the purview of the appealable provisions of the guidelines so I am not inclined to interfere in the matter and accordingly this petition is dismissed.
