ORDER



The instant appeal petition is directed against the impugned order passed by D.M. Siwan as contained in Memo No. 1131/estt. dt. 30.08.2005 whereby and whereunder the appellatant, a Revenue Karmchari was inflicted with certain punishment.

2. It is seen that the appellatant filed CWJC No. 4026/2009 against the said punishment order but while disposing the matter, the Hon'ble High Court directed the appellatant to avail the alternative remedy of appeal. In pursuance to that the appellatant filed a case before this Court on 12.08.2011 and the said case was admitted by this Court vide order dt. 17.09.2011 and accordingly LCR was called for. But it is highly unfortunate that on all subsequent dates i.e. 17.12.11, 28.04.12, 19.09.12, 18.12.12 and 26.12.13 the appellatant was absent or filed time petition.

3. Thus from the aforementioned facts, it is quite obvious that the appellatant is not interested in pursuing his case.

4. For the reason aforesaid, I am not inclined to prolong this case further and accordingly the same is dismissed for default.
