## **ORDER**

## 30.03.2013

The instant appeal petition is directed against the impugned order passed by Inspector, Offices of Registration, Saran Division, Chapra on 29.05.08 whereby and whereunder the appellant was directed to deposit a deficit stamp fee of Rs. 13724 and registration fee thereto.

- Aggrieved by the aforesaid order, the appellant preferred an appeal before this Court challenging the said order. This case was admitted by this Court on 19.05.2009 and accordingly LCR was called for. When the case was taken up for final hearing on 05.03.2013, the learned counsel for the appellant offered his willingness to deposit 50 percent of the outstanding dues against the appellant within 10 days. This Court was pleased to grant such liberty to the appellant.
- 3. Again, when the case was taken up on 19.03.2013, the learned counsel for the appellant expressed his inability to convince the Court as to whether the earlier order dt.05.03.2013 has been complied with or not by the appellant and prayed for disposing off of the matter.
- 4. The learned Govt. pleader also supported the view that as the appellant failed to deposit mandatory 50% of the outstanding dues, the appeal should be dismissed.
- In view of the aforesaid position, I do not find any substantial reason to decide the case on merit in view of the fact that the appellant blatantly failed to comply with the earlier order dt.05.03.2013 of this Court which he undertook to comply with and he has not filed any piece of paper stating something otherwise.

6. Thus this appeal is dismissed.
