ORDER

The instant appeal is preferred against the impugned order passed by District Magistrate, Siwan as contained in Memo No. 293/Estt. dt. 04.05.2009 whereby and whereunder the appellant was imposed with certain punishment after the finding arrived at in a duly conducted Departmental Proceeding against the appellant.

2. Initially the matter was dealt with in the establishment section of the office and accordingly original record was called for. It is seen from the ordersheet that in the beginning the appellant filed his presence through his advocate on 03.03.2011 but he was absent on the following subsequent dates viz 06.04.11, 04.06.11, 04.07.11, 13.08.11, 28.04.12, 19.06.12, 11.09.12, 18.12.12 and 05.03.13 but on two dates he filed haziri and prayed for time.

3. In view of the aforesaid position, it is quite obvious that the attitude of the petitioner is not very conducive to expeditions disposed of his case. No useful purpose would be served in prolonging the case. As such I am not inclined to prolong this case any more, hence the same is dismissed for default.
