## In The Court of Commissioner, Saran Division, Chapra

Supply Revision No. 32/2014

Prahlad Sharan Vrs. State of Bihar ORDER

by D.M. Saran in Supply Appeal case No. 47/2013 on 19.12.2013.

The brief facts of the case are that the father of the present petitioner Late Ram Baran Prasad was a PDS licencee of ward No. 6 of Nagar Panchayat Dighwara of Saran District. Further case is that the licence of the dealer was cancelled by SDO, Sonpur vide order dt. 09.09.2011 for some reasons. Meanwhile, the licencee died on 09.06.2012. Thereafter, the present petitioner, S/o of the licencee, filed a case before D.M. Saran for revival of the said licence but the said case was dismissed for non-prosecution by D.M. Saran vide order dt. 19.12.13 and against that order, the present revision case has been preferred before this Court.

Heard.

The learned counsel for the petitioner forwarded his arguments mainly on the point that as the licencee died after cancellation of his licence, the petitioner being his son can claim for the grant of the said licence on the compassionate ground. At this stage, the learned Spl.P.P. intervened and stated that the petitioner does not have any locus standi to file this case as such the same is not maintainable and the same deserves to be dismissed.

Having heard the learned counsel for the parties I do not find any merit in the claim of the petitioner. This revision petition being also devoid of any merit in view of the relevant provisions of PDS (control) order-2001 before this Court, does not warrant any consideration now.

In view of the aforementioned position, this revision application is dismissed for want of maintainability.
