

Subject: Debarment of Institution for conducting CRE programme:-reg.

This is for information that the Christian Medical College, Vellore was approved to conduct the CRE programme (CRE-25041212464004) to conduct a State level CRE from 23-24 May 2025 with a maximum intake of 150 participants. However, as per the norms of the Council, the CRE report must be submitted by the host institution within two days after completion of the programme. The said institute has not yet submitted the CRE report through online CRE portal. Due to this, the participants had submitted several complaints through emails to this Council and the higher authorities for updating the CRE points, whereas, it is for information that the Council could not update CRE points due to non-receipt of the report, which is a fault of the host institution.

In light of the above, it has been found that the host institution has not followed the CRE norms in conducting the CRE programme. Accordingly, as per the Office Memorandum No. 7-16/CRE(Policy)/RCI dated 14.10.2025, the institution namely Christian Medical College, Vellore is debarred from conducting Continuing Rehabilitation Education (CRE) Programmes for a period of two years from the date of issue of this Office Memorandum and 20 CRE points may be deducted from the CRE Coordinator's account.
