**Report on First IBFF Partially Sighted Football National
Championship 2025**

The 1st Edition of IBFF Partially Sighted Football National Championship 2025 was held on 24th and 25th March 2025. at Atal Bihari Vajpayee Training Centre for Disability Sports-Gwalior (M.P.)

The IBFF Partially Sighted Football National Championship 2025 tournament marked a major milestone for Partially Sighted Football players in India. With **08 states** set to participate with around **110 participants**, including Partially Sighted Football players, coaches, and match officials, this event was one of the largest national Partially Sighted Football that had been hosted to date. The states that participated were Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Delhi, Odisha, Andhra Pradesh, Haryana, Uttarakhand and host Madhya Pradesh. In this tournament, **1st place goes to Kerla, 2nd place goes to Odisha, and on the 3rd position was Uttarakhand.**
