


Message

C COVID-19 pandemic has been affecting all spheres of human life. It has also generated a major health, economic, social and political crisis. There has been a hoard of disputes in trades and businesses spread across sectors: banking, consumers, basic essential services / public utilities etc. People have been lessening behind payments; potential job losses and pay cuts that have direct impact on default in loan payments. Preventive measures to confront COVID-19 have been affecting the working of the judicial forums from the Magisterial Court to the Supreme Court of India. The Supreme Court and various High Courts across India have already adopted video-conferencing tools to become virtual courts and hear urgent matters. Ministry of Law and Justice, Government of India, has also issued an Online Dispute Resolution (ODR) notification in 2017, urging government departments to use ODR platform across the country to resolve pending cases efficiently.

Rajasthan State Legal Services Authority has been working with new methodologies in view of the emerging scenario as per local conditions and circumstances. Section 19 of Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987 provides for organization of Lok Adalat at all level i.e from Supreme Court to Taluka level at regular intervals that is an ingenious ADR mechanism and is one of the most successful programme of the Legal Services Authorities in promoting inclusive legal system. Therefore, during this unprecedented time and in view of the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court to promote technology in the Indian Justice System, a proposal to hold Online Lok Adalat for pending and pre litigation cases with the technical support of Sama, an ODR (Online Dispute Resolution) platform, recognized by Ministry of Law and Justice, Government of India was submitted by Rajasthan State Legal Services Authority as Online Dispute Resolution (ODR) involves the application of technology to dispute resolution processes. It leverages the capacity of the internet to support the creation, sharing and retention of dispute resolution communications as well as its ability to support multiple forms of interactions, including text, voice and video. ODR can support a range of dispute resolution processes, from direct party-to-party negotiation to mediation and adjudication. Thus, the technology plays the role of facilitator to keep the wheels of justice rolling in order to provide viable Access to Justice and facilitate resolution of legal problems.

This unique Lok Adalat was first one in Rajasthan conducted digitally through Online Dispute Resolution (ODR) Platform wherein RLSA, Courts/Financial Institutions and Service Provider Sama were the key stakeholders. The operational framework of the Online Lok Adalat was devised by RLSA in a manner as to ensure its accessibility in far flung areas also for the common masses. Accordingly, the online strategy included various mixed tools such as digital platform through the service provider Sama, what's app video calling and telephonic calls. The parties to dispute need not to visit courts physically but could appear through any of the online available mode i.e. Sama chat, what's app video calling, telephonic calls or any other mode. After counseling of both the parties by legal experts draft agreement of settlement was prepared on agreed conditions of parties and signed digitally by both the parties. The best part of the whole process was secure system wherein, in case of settlement the identification of parties was ensured through unique OTP sent on his/her registered mobile phone to undertake their digital signatures over the agreement of settlement. The online mode was completely new therefore; unyielding strategy was adopted in order to ensure best result with significant outcomes.

AIM

To provide virtual platform to ensure access to justice on the basis of equal opportunity during pandemic;

OBJECTIVES

To introduce information technology in justice delivery system;

To settle disputes which are pending before courts during pandemic following the COVID -19 guidelines issued by Govt.;

To provide amicable solution to the dispute;

Operational Framework

Online Lok Adalat operational framework was designed in a way to allow cases to be seamlessly resolved without traveling by any party. All participants could hear and see each other. The bench was able to engage the parties in meaningful settlement discussion just as if all were present at the same location. It might be the future new

normal for organizing Lok Adalat. This was also imperative for a State like Rajasthan which is largest in terms of area and having around 75% of the population living in rural areas.

- Participating financial institutions refer their pending banking matters to Rajasthan State Legal Services Authority (RSLSA);
- Courts refer cases which can be settled through Lok Adalat;
- RSLSA through DLSAs send notices to the customers/parties through email, what's app and text messages (using online platform), inviting them to resolve their pending banking matters with financial institutions;
- On the basis of consents received from the parties, RSLSA prepare and allocate cases to counselor for pre-counseling;
- Prepare and execute plan of online meeting between parties and counselor;
- Appoint sufficient number of trained counselors from the Panel of Retired Judges to conduct the proceedings which includes pre-counseling sessions;
- Schedule pre-counseling sessions and accordingly preparation of cause list of the cases, suitable to be listed before the Lok Adalat;
- Maintenance of records and preparation of settlement with consent of both the parties and also share the final settlement with the Courts;
- Publishing and endorsing the data on their website of the total number of cases resolved;
- Access of Sama platform (<https://www.sama.live/>) having following features:-
 - Electronic filing of cases in Bulk,
 - Invitation notice by RSLSA through message, email and/or what's app,
 - Recording consents of litigants, online appointment of counselors for pre-counseling, document & uploading, video-conferencing, online chat and audio support for pre-counseling sessions,
 - Lok Adalat Award templates, electronic signature, online feedback process,
 - Generate MIS report on total number of cases filed, consents received and cases resolved,
 - Training support to Lawyers, Parties, Counselors, Bench Members and Bank Representatives on how to use the platform for Online Lok Adalat, and online support in cases where are queries.




STRATEGY ADOPTED



The concept of Online Lok Adalat was up-to-the-minute for all of us therefore, the effective planning and efficacious supervision was the key of success of the programme that to novel modalities were prepared in order to implement the programme successfully in diverse State with local challenges i.e. public at large lives in rural / remote areas; minimal access of internet and phone facilities; speaks in local dialect and unable to understand the procedure of justice administration.



The strategy devised for conducting the Online Lok Adalat is reflected in the following flow chart :



The work strategy was devised keeping in view the essential components incorporating novel components such as:

Orientation

Awareness

Identification of the Cases

Registration

Service of Notices

Obtaining of Consent of other party/parties

Pre-Counseling

Settlement Draft

Passing of an award by Lok Adalat Bench

Orientation

Keeping all in view the project was launched with organization of several orientation programmes for concerned stakeholders i.e. Retired District & Session Judges, Chairman PLA, System Offices, Judicial Officers, Secretaries, DLSAs, Bar Presidents & Advocates, Banks, Insurance Officers, Financial Institutions and various departments just to make them understand what the Online Lok Adalat is and how it is going to work. Realization of their role was

the motto of orientation since they were in direct connect with the parties. It is very important to mention here that all the programmes of orientation were organised virtually on e-platform 'Cisco-Webex'. A total number of 30 orientation



programmes were organised to trained 4784 personals in all. Daily updates and technical issues coming before all Districts were taken up on daily basis through meetings on Webex.

Awareness

A programme can be implemented successfully only when public is involved. Though Lok Adalats are very popular and successful in Rajasthan but when it comes to online no one knows what is it, so as to make people aware publicity was most necessary. Therefore, Posters in regional language 'Hindi' in a very simplest manner were prepared and published in local news papers, website of RLSA & Rajasthan High Court as well as on social media platforms i.e. Youtube, Twitter, Instagram and Facebook. Alike, programmes on Aakashwani, local radio channels, TV channels were streamed and all other modes of publicity were adopted.



All DLSAs were also directed to post news on the website of District Courts.

Type of Cases

The Online Lok Adalat was conceptualized to settle pending as well as cases at pre-litigation stage.

Pre-Litigation

- Disputes relating to recovery of money

Pending Cases

- Cases registered under Section 138 of NI Act
- Money Recovery Cases
- MACT Cases
- Family Disputes (Except Divorce)
- Labour & Employment Matters
- Other civil cases which can be settled through ODR

Identification

Identification of the cases was imperative for referral. All the financial institutions and presiding officers of the Courts were directed to identify cases keeping in view the new platform of Online Lok Adalat. The factors primarily considered were (a) elements of settlement in a case (b) availability of emails and phone numbers of the parties (c) cases not involving complex issues of law and fact. For both pre-litigation and pending litigation matters, any party could file the application with contact details through email, helpline number, what's app, google form or online filing form at RLSA/DLSA.

Common man friendly mechanism was designed and adopted wherein helpline number of DLSAs, emails, official number of Secretaries were made available to parties and Advocates where they could send details of the cases for referral. The list of numbers and emails were published on website, news papers as well as publicized through local news channels.

How to Get Referred

Courts - Identify Appropriate Cases and send to DLSA

Bank/Insurance/ Financial Institutions - Email list of Cases to DLSAs

Party/Advocate - Send Case Details on Telephone, Email, Helpline Number of DLSA or Request to Concerned Court

Cases of pre-litigation and pending were taken up in Online Lok Adalat. All the Courts and Bank/Insurance/Financial Institutions were directed to send details of identified cases in prescribed format A and B identically designed for pre-litigation and pending cases.

Consent

Case Managers established contact with parties telephonically and briefed about the whole process enable them to understand the methodology of Online Lok Adalat. Cases of consenting parties were referred for counseling and relevant documents were uploaded on the portal of Sama for Counselor to understand the cause of dispute between the parties.



Pre-Counseling



Day to Day cause list of consented cases for each District was prepared by Secretary of respective DLSA and the same was sent to Sama, Pre-Counselor, Case Managers and RLSA. Subsequently, Case Managers informed parties and their Advocates about the date and time of the virtual counseling session and advised them to present with relevant documents so that documents could be exchanged with Pre-Counselor.

The Pre-Counseling primarily facilitated the roadmap for settlement of the disputes. Pre-Counseling before legal experts was aimed to reach to consensus and amicable solution for settlement. Retired Hon'ble Judges, Retired District Judges and Chairman PLAs were designated as Counselors in each District. Pre-Counseling was arranged virtually wherein parties & their Advocates and Counselor were connected virtually i.e. Sama chats, video calls, what's app video calls & voice calls.

The Counseling was started from 4th August, 2020 to 21st August, 2020 in each District with the help of designated Counselors.


In successful cases, agreement of settlement were prepared on agreed conditions between the parties and same were sent on what's app to concerned parties and their advocates for consideration and necessary amendments. After amendments, final agreements were sent on registered email or registered mobile number for e-signatures of both the parties.

In order to ensure authentic signing, e - signatures were authenticated through system generated OTP sent on registered mobile numbers of both the parties.

Constitution of Benches

DLSA in each District constituted the Lok Adalat Benches presided over by a sitting judicial officer as Chairman with one Advocate as member. The benches were constituted taking into account the total number of referred cases. A total number of 351 benches were constituted across the State.

Settlement before the Bench

Settled matters along with the e-agreement were placed before the bench of Lok Adalat and signature of Advocate was obtained physically or digitally if Advocate was engaged in other court or out of station for some reason or otherwise.



The step by step process mentioned above was meticulously designed and applied so that there remain no loop holes where any party felt discontented or contemptuous. The whole process was designed in a manner to ensure strict compliance of the guidelines issued to prevent the spread of COVID-19.



CHALLENGES



70% of the total population of Rajasthan resides in villages with low level of literacy, minimum access of telephone and internet facilities and speak in local dialect that resulted into various obstacles in way to Online Lok Adalat such as lack of trust and confidence, cultural, educational and language barriers, negative mind set and many more.

ACHIEVEMENTS



There stands no doubt as to the necessity of Online Lok Adalat during this unprecedented time of COVID-19. Initially people were hesitant and some kind of fear in adopting virtual hearings but gradually OLA has made it possible that Lok Adalat Bench is at one place, parties and lawyer in other and they all carry on proceedings in an Electronic room.

As a result of tireless efforts 33546 cases were settled through compromise and awards of Rs 2700949313 were passed. The success rate is 46.53% as 72090 number cases were referred across Rajasthan. Though the whole system was designed and implemented online but in some of the cases where parties approached to the courts for keeping their cases and wanted to settled were also referred before Lok Adalat Benches as Lok Adalat is very popular in Rajasthan and people have deep trust in the system therefore, those cases were taken up offline.

Virtual Accomplishment Ceremony of Online Lok Adalat 22nd August, 2020

The Virtual Accomplishment Ceremony of the Online Lok Adalat was held on 22nd August, 2020 presided by Hon'ble Mr. Justice N. V. Ramana, Judge, Supreme Court of India & Executive Chairman, NALSA in the august presence of Hon'ble Mr. Justice Ajay Rastogi, Judge, Supreme Court of India, Hon'ble Mr. Justice Dinesh Maheshwari, Judge, Supreme Court of India, Hon'ble Mr. Justice Indrajit Mahanty, Chief Justice, Rajasthan High Court & Patron-in-Chief, RLSA and Hon'ble Mr. Justice Sangeet Lodha, Judge, Rajasthan High Court & Executive Chairman, RLSA.

Presidential Address by Hon'ble Mr. Justice N.V. Ramana Judge, Supreme Court of India & Executive Chairman, NALSA



Hon'ble Mr. Justice N.V. Ramana, Judge, Supreme Court of India & Executive Chairman, NALSA said that the pandemic has caused disruptions and forced institutions to conceptualize and adopt innovative technological solutions to function within the constraints of public health guidelines. The present circumstances, requires the integration of technology allowing remote contact less support to facilitate 'Access to Justice'. Legal Services Institutions having a large network of working towards solution based methodology making appreciable and visible changes at grass-roots. The concept of Online Lok Adalat has the potential of transforming the legal landscape of India, and is reflective of the innovative approach being adopted by Legal Services Authorities since the onset of the pandemic.

His Lordship said "We have to ensure that E-Lok Adalat remains the 'People's Lok Adalat' and take it to other parts of the country. Introduction of Online Lok Adalat is a well-organized digital solution in the form of Online Dispute Resolution (ODR) which will give new impetus to Lok Adalats in India". His Lordship also emphasized to ensure availability of Online Lok Adalats down to the grassroots level where the facility of video conference is not always available.

His Lordship also appreciated RLSA's, initiative of Online Lok Adalat whereby all 36 judicial Districts were covered and cases at pre-litigation as well as at pending were taken up.

His Lordship further said that the Legal Services Authorities also received numerous grievances relating to denial of wages that were not gone unnoticed by the Legal Services Authorities whereupon assistance was provided to 57,79,546 migrants in coordination with the District Administration in terms of transit, food, and medical aid. Legal Services Authorities across the Country have evolved procedures to ensure implementation of directions for easing pressure on prisons and provided legal assistance to 22,024 under trial prisoners during trial, 19,184 persons at the remand stage, wherein 8,779 bail applications have been filed for such persons at the remand stage out of which 6,113 applications have been allowed. 6,311 convicts were assisted in filing applications for parole/furlough. Legal Services Authorities have been trying to keep up with the changing times by using technology as its strongest aide. Legal Services Authorities with the aid of the National Legal Aid Helpline and State Legal Aid Helpline effectively provided legal advice and assistance in 6,26,369 cases.

His Lordship further said "NALSA is continuously striving to ensure justice to be accessible in such unprecedented time therefore, the role of Legal Aid Institutions has become all the more important. In order to ameliorate the situation, a broad range of legal services have to be provided to the needy including victims of domestic violence, daily wagers, tenants, under trials, convicts and migrants."

In the end His Lordship said "E-Lok Adalat movement in Rajasthan will pave the way forward to other State Legal Services Authorities to make this a successful venture throughout the Country".

Address by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Ajay Rastogi Judge, Supreme Court of India



Hon'ble Mr. Justice Ajay Rastogi, Judge, Supreme Court of India said "Rajasthan is a biggest geographical State where this Online Dispute Resolution Mechanism will impute great achievement for 75% of its population residing in rural and far flung areas". His Lordship further added that ADR mechanism has been introduced for various reasons but primary to find out better acceptable mechanism to resolve dispute amicably. Pre pandemic - 19, it was the common perception that the matters could be amicably resolved only in the physical presence of the litigating parties who are in right of the presiding officers but massive Covid-19 pandemic has brought shift from physical to virtual and provided an opportunity to access with technology that resulted into positive benefits and constructive outcomes in order to deliver justice.

His Lordship further said that the present innovation of holding an Online Dispute Resolution through Lok Adalat or People's Courts is a system which decides the dispute with utmost expedition to arrive at a compromise or settlement on the basis of principles of justice, equity, fair play and other legal principles. The failure to provide equal justice to all, threatens the stability of our institution. The alternative dispute mechanism has to reach to the disadvantaged persons residing in the remote corners of the Country at their doorstep.

Address by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Dinesh Maheshwari

Hon'ble Mr. Justice Dinesh Maheshwari, Judge Supreme Court of India said that the motto of National Legal Services Authority is "Access to Justice for All". It is that motto of all, "One for All and All for One". Hon'ble Judges, members of subordinate judiciary, staff, members of bar and every single role player in justice delivery system has been working for the institution in Rajasthan. His Lordship further stated that resultant situation due to pandemic has forced to adopt new ways for sustainable and ongoing Access to Justice. This is why Online Dispute Resolution (ODR) to be a transformative mechanism for resolving disputes.

His Lordship praised the efforts of the Rajasthan State Legal Services Authority for reaching out to the needy and marginalized sections of the society as well as for successful organization of Online Lok Adalat across Rajasthan even in remote areas where connectivity itself is a problem.

Apart from great amount of work done by RLSA even during pandemic, Rajasthan High Court has also disposed of maximum cases in Country. His Lordship further said "We have been continuing hearing in Courts virtually and personally though facing challenges but vigilant and taking necessary steps to overcome". He also highlighted the crucial role being performed by Legal Services Institutions in the State of Rajasthan.

His Lordship commenced with the quote of Hon'ble Mr. Justice V. R. Krishna Iyer "Society is guilty if anyone suffers injustice" and further said that NALSA and SLSAs have been working to achieve the noble goal of providing legal services to citizen in distress and need. Under the aegis of NALSA, RSLSA has conducted first ever Online Lok Adalat in the State of Rajasthan amid to restricted judicial functioning owing to Covid-19 outbreak wherein thousands of legal disputes were taken up with technical support of Sama through specially designed digital platform.

His Lordship further added that since 75% population of Rajasthan lives in rural and far-flung areas, it was a challenge to make Online Lok Adalat accessible to the persons living in the villages. From the very beginning this aspect was kept in view and the operational framework of Online Lok Adalat was accordingly devised wherein they may not only get familiar with the online system but participate in it. The accomplishment of first ever Online Lok Adalat was designed taking technology within the domain of ODF unraveling all barriers be with time or distance.

His Lordship further said "I am happy to inform you that Online Lok Adalat has been successfully organised across the State even in aspirational Districts such as Barmer, Dholpur, Jaisalmer, Karauli and Sirohi". The unique feature of Online Lok Adalat is the ease with which pending and pre-litigation cases have been taken up and expeditiously settled.

His Lordship further added that RSLSA intends to organize more such Lok Adalats in near future to reach out the burden on system and to promote expeditiously resolution of pre-litigation and pending cases in a digital manner. From the very beginning of onset of Covid- 19, RSLSA has been sincerely making all efforts to

meaningfully implement its motto "Access to Justice for All". RLSA is sensitive towards needs of all potential beneficiaries particularly those who are marginalized and in a great need of legal aid, especially in this pandemic time. RLSA is not only providing court based legal services but also reaching masses through outreach legal services from the sufficient and committed workforce by devising and implementing programmes suitable to local scenario. Plantation of more than 2 lacs trees as against the target of 1 lac. trees, webinars, programme on Aakashwani namely "Balwani" are exemplar of innovative outreach activities. In order to ensure wider coverage of marginalized section of the society the upcoming projects of RLSA accentuate on migrant workers, dropout children, domestic violence victims and girl child education.

In the end, His Lordship assured everyone that RLSA will continue and tirelessly strive to address and adopt new challenges while working towards the object of legal aid enshrined in Article 39 A of the Constitution of India.





Rajasthan makes history with 1st online Lok Adalat

Jaipur: In a first, an online Lok Adalat was held in view of the ongoing corona pandemic.

A total of seven benches were set up by district legal services authority for the online Lok Adalat in which the benches heard parties to settle their grievances. Though the number of matters which were listed was low, the initiative turned out to be a successful experiment.

The online Lok Adalat was held in the supervision of Rajasthan Legal Services Authority member Brijesh Kumar Jain and joint secretary Dev Kumar Khatri.

The state government also withdrew more than 8,000 petty cases. Advocates were also made members in the benches along with the judges. In one of the benches, district authority secretary Siddheswar Puri conducted a hearing with advocate Pramendra Puri. Awards were also passed after compromise between the parties.

In the closing ceremony, Supreme Court justice Dinesh Maheshari said that the country is passing through a new phase and new possibilities will have to be explored after the corona pandemic is over.

Speaking in the ceremony, chief justice of Rajasthan high court Indrajit Mahanty said that it was a matter of pride that National Legal Services Authority (NALSA) chose the state for this pilot project.

Justice Ajay Rastogi said that Rajasthan is witnessing a new start of online Lok Adalat. National Legal Services Authority (NALSA) chairman justice NV Ramana, also addressed the ceremony and appreciated the move.

RSLSA is all set to organize its 1st online Lok Adalat in consonance with NLSA in the whole of State of Rajasthan. Aspirational Districts such as Jaisalmer, Sirohi, Dhaulpur, Barmer and Karauli were also included in the list. A total of 47,654 cases were taken up in Lok Adalats. The opening ceremony of the online Lok Adalat was attended by many itinerary's such as Justice N V Ramana, Judge of Supreme Court and Justice Ajay Rastogi, SC Judge and Executive Chairman of NLSA.

जस्टिस रमना ने कहा, "ई-लोक अदालत ऐसे कठिन समय में एक ऐसी सेवा है। ऑनलाइन विवाद समाधान (ODR), प्रीतिरोगी और ADR के संयोजन के रूप में बहुचर्चीत डिजिटल समाधान, भारत में लोक अदालतों को गति देगा। हालांकि, महत्वपूर्ण चुनौती ई-लोक अदालत के विचार को निचले स्तर तक लोकप्रिय बनाने की है, और उन क्षेत्रों में पहुंचाने की है, जहां वीडियो कॉन्फ्रेंसिंग की सुविधा भी नहीं है।

सुप्रीम कोर्ट के जज, जस्टिस अजय रस्तोगी ने कहा, "न्यायिक वितरण की एक ऐसी प्रणाली, जो गरीबों की पहुंच में हो, हमारे न्याय की गुणवत्ता का पैमाना है। सभी को समान न्याय प्रदान करने में विफलता हमारी समता की विचारता को खारिज में आती है।" उन्होंने कहा कि वैकल्पिक विवाद लव को देश के दूरस्थ कोनों में रहने वाले वंचित वर्गियों तक पहुंचाना है।

जस्टिस दिनेश माहेचुरी ने राजस्थान राज्य विधिक सेवा प्राधिकरण के समापन के उत्सवों और इतिहास पर पड़े सभी तक पहुंचने के प्रयासों की प्रशंसा की। जस्टिस इंद्रजीत माहंती ने कहा कि महामारी के दौरान राजस्थान हाईकोर्ट ने अधिकतम मामलों का निपटारा किया। उन्होंने राजस्थान राज्य में विधिक सेवा संभवतः द्वारा की जा रही महत्वपूर्ण भूमिका पर भी प्रशंसा जताया।

जस्टिस संगीत लोढ़ा ने कहा कि अरएसएलएसए विवाद धर्मिक में ऐसे और अधिक लोक अदालतों के आयोजन का इरादा रखता है।

रातसा ने राजस्थान में ऑनलाइन लोक अदालत को घाघरत प्रोमोवट के रूप में शुरू किया है और इसे देश के अन्य हिस्सों में विकसित करने की योजना बना रही है। परियोजना को मई, 2020 में मंजूरी दी गई थी।
