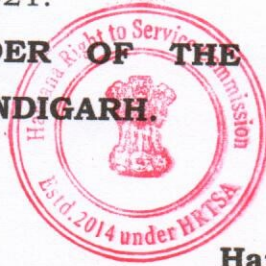

In response to the Show Cause Notice issued vide letter No. 1212 dated 09.08.2021, Sh. Ajay Pal Duddi, Deputy Labour Commissioner, Faridabad appeared for personal hearing. He stated that a reply dated bearing No. 3198 dated 23.08.2021 has already been sent to the Commission. He further stated that only one service is being rendered by the Deputy Labour Commissioner, Faridabad i.e. Grant of Licenses to the Contractors under the provisions of the Contract Labour Act, 1970 and renewal thereof, in which he has not defaulted. As far as the pendency pointed out by the Deputy Commissioner, Faridabad in his DO letter 26.07.2021 is concerned, same pertains to Building and Construction Workers and is not dealt by him and therefore, he requested for dropping of the Show Cause Notice issued to him.

On perusal of the record, the statement made by the Deputy Labour Commissioner, Faridabad was found to be correct. Moreover, after issuance of the Show Cause Notice dated 09.08.2021, Shri Pankaj Agarwal, IAS, Labour Commissioner, Haryana was called for discussions and review on 6th September, 2021 keeping in mind huge pendency of cases pertaining to Building and Construction Workers and it was ascertained that the problem is at the State Headquarters level instead of in the districts. The Labour Commissioner, Haryana has been asked to implement the revamped system immediately and bring down the pendency within next one month. Hence, there is no fault on the part of the district officials in this regard and this Suo Moto Notice issued to Deputy Labour Commissioner, Faridabad is hereby dropped.
