Mrs. Priyanka Soni, IAS, District Magistrate Hisar appeared in response of Suo Moto Notice No. HRTSC/SM-019/Home/1496 dated 15.09.2021. It was stated by her that the delay in taking decision in this case was entirely due to two reason i.e. firstly the report sent by SP, Hisar was not clear and thereafter when a clear cut report was asked from, there was delay on his part in sending the report. After receipt of the report from SP, Hisar dated 25.03.2021, from decision has been taken and the application had been disposed of. The Commission was informed also about it on 22.04.2021. It was also stated by that the Grant of Arms License was notified as Sr. No. 177 (I) only w.e.f 01.03.2021.

I have carefully gone through the file. First Suo Moto Notice in this case was issued on 25.02.2021 after receipt of the complaint. The applicant had applied for Grant of Arms License on 14.08.2019 which was promptly sent to SP, Hisar on 14.08.2019 itself. The report from SP, Hisar dated 17.08.2020 was received which was not clear and therefore SP, Hisar was asked to send clear-cut report on 01.10.2020 which was received late i.e. on 25.03.2021. After receipt of this report, decision has been promptly taken and communicated to the applicant as well as to the Commission on 22.04.2021. In this case, Grant of Arms License was notified at Sr. No. 177 (I) w.e.f 01.03.2021 but the notice was issued on 25.02.2021 and therefore, issuance of notice itself was not in accordance with law. Moreover, the decision has already been taken by the DM, Hisar based on police report and informed to the Commission vide letter no. 1405/P.L. dated 22.04.2021. There is no fault on the part of DM, Hisar and therefore, the Show Cause Notice is hereby filed qua her. However, there is definitely delay on the part of SP, Hisar in sending the report firstly from 16.08.2019 to 17.08.2020 and secondly from 06.10.2020 to 25.03.2021 while as per the notification, SP, Hisar should have send the verification report within 22 days. SP, Hisar vide his letter dated 13.08.2021 by giving reference to his earlier letter dated 04.05.2021 as explained the reasons for delay in sending the report from 06.10.2020 to 25.03.2021, which are also not satisfactory there is no explanation for delay from 06.10.2020 till 25.03.2021. The delay of one year i.e. 16.08.2019 to 17.08.2020 remains and explained, therefore, SP, Hisar be asked to explain the reasons as to why there was delay of more than one year in sending the earlier report dated 17.08.2020 and thereafter from 06.10.2020
