This is in continuation of suo moto notice no. 707/CC/HRTSC/2021 dated 23.06.2021 issued to EO, HSVP, Gurugram with directions to furnish the information in respect of plot no. GH43/52 which was delayed by 42 days & plot no. 1507/52 which was delayed by 11 days. Pursuant to the said notice Smt. Manisha Sharma appeared in person and furnished her explanation regarding the delay caused by her in delivery of notified services of grant of occupation certificate. During the said hearing she was asked to supply information to the Commission regarding certain cases informed by her as a part of the said information. The said information was duly supplied by her, based upon which, show cause notices were issued to Smt. Manisha Sharma, HCS & Sh. Vivek Kalia, HCS for 23.08.2021 Both these officers had furnished their respective explanations based upon which this instant suo moto notice was issued to Sh. Mukesh Kumar, Clerk & Sh. Balraj Singh, Accountant, EO-II, HSVP, Gurugram vide Commission notice no. HRTSC/SM-002(iii)/HSVP/1670 dated 02.10.2021 wherein they were directed to send their reply in respect of plot no. 2369/57 where 34 working days had been taken for issuance of conveyance deed instead of notified period of 20 working days. In his reply Sh. Balraj Singh has stated that the delay occurred in processing of Conveyance Deed, which was not intentional but it occurred as he was on official tour to the office of Chief Administrator/Chief Controller of Finance, HSVP, (HQ), Panchkula from 24.02.2021 to 04.03.2021 in connection with the LFSS Scheme, which was to be launched by the Hon'ble Chief Minister, Haryana on 03.03.2021. Further, he submitted that he attended the office on 05.03.2021 and 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> March, 2021 were Saturday and Sunday and on the next working day i.e. 8<sup>th</sup> March, 2021, the case was processed and sent on the ID of dealing Assistant for further process. The contentions raised by Sh. Balraj Singh, Accountant are accepted since being on duty to HQ from 24.02.2021 to 04.03.2021 was something beyond his control and he cannot be held liable for the same. The explanation is accepted and accordingly suo moto notice is filed qua him. Sh. Mukesh Kumar stated during the hearing that the file was in the custody of record keeper and thus, he sought time to consult the record and submit reply. His request was accorded to and he was directed to submit reply by 02.11.2021.
