It is true that he had taken 36 working days at the initial stage in preparing the inspection report and sending the same to the Competent Authority i.e. the Director General, Fire Services, Haryana. Keeping in mind huge area of 24 acres, same is satisfactory. However, the notice was issued because the reply to the clarification sought by Director General Fire Services on 18.08.2020 was replied to on 24.11.2020 i.e. after more than three months. Sh. Satyawar Samriwal has enclosed a request letter dated 31-08-2020 of the applicant in which they themselves requested three months time for rectifying the observations. Therefore, Sh. Satyawar Samriwal cannot be held responsible for this delay as he forwarded the case to headquarters immediately after the rectifications were removed. This request of the applicant dated 31.08.2020 was not disclosed by the officials of Fire Department during any of the hearings before the Commission. In view of these facts and circumstances, the reply of Sh. Satyawar Samriwal is found to be satisfactory and hence, the *suo moto* notice issued to him is ordered to be filed.
