
Subject: Regarding delay in sending Viscera report by FSL.

Please refer to the subject cited above. This is to bring to your notice that the Haryana Right to Service Commission has completed district visit to all the 22 Districts of Haryana from 23.08.2021 to 06.10.2021 and Departmental review meetings of all 31 Departments under its ambit. During these interactions, the issue of huge pendency in the delivery of notified service No. 92 (under Haryana Right to Service Act, 2014) named as "Mukhya Mantri Kisan Avam Khetihar Mazdoor Jeevan Suraksha Yojana, 2003" under Department of Agriculture, Government of Haryana on account of viscera reports being pending at the end of Haryana State Forensic Laboratory has caught the attention of the Commission.

In order to take corrective measures in the matter, HSAMB was asked to provide data of actual pendency of the cases under the said scheme on account of non-receipt of viscera report from FSL. Perusal of the said information reveals that viscera report in cases as old as the year 2014 are pending at your end despite reminders from the office of HSAMB. You will agree that if benefits are delayed, which is happening in large number of cases at present, the whole purpose of the Scheme is being defeated. Ideally speaking, the report should be sent in 30 days' maximum so that the financial benefit of Rs 5 lacs can be released to the family of the deceased in time.

You are, therefore, requested to furnish your comments regarding delayed cases as conveyed to Haryana Right to Service Commission by HSAMB, not later than 19.11.2021 (copy enclosed).
