Ms. Wahida Hamid put in appearance through V-C in response to suo-moto notice dated 25-11-2021. She stated that she joined as SHO Mansa Devi complex on 17/07/2021 before

which Sh. Sushil Kumar Inspector was in charge of the said police station. She had no details of the case with her and denied knowledge of receipt of notice whereas as per office record of the Commission, notice stands delivered through e-mail on the official e-mail ID of the officer. On being asked if she checked her mail, she replied that the mail was not flagged to her by her PSI and Police Station Munshi. There was no seriousness in the officer qua the hearing and she was totally clueless about the case. However, she assured to submit the reply by tomorrow. Also, despite advance notice and e-mail intimation, no officer/official appeared from DCP office with record to assist the Commission which is not a very happy situation. It is needless to mention again that there has been a colossal delay in the matter and the DCP office seems to be answering correspondence from the Commission in a routine manner.

Be that as it may, let DCP Panchkula personally appear before the Commission on 03/01/2022 at 10:30 AM with entire record to clarify his position in the matter. Shri Sushil Kumar, Inspector be also issued suo-moto notice to send reply by 7<sup>th</sup> January, 2022 after consulting the record, If no reply is received from either Ms. Wahida Hamid or Shri Sushil Kumar, Inspector, their personal presence will be sought.
