With reference to show cause notice issued vide No. 758 dated 02.07.2021, Shri Gulshan kalra, Deputy Director attended the proceedings.

After detailed discussions, directions / observations of the Commission are as under:-

In response to Show Cause Notice issued vide No. 758 dated 02.07.2021, Shri Gulshan Kalra, Deputy Director has appeared through Video Conferencing today at 10.00 am. At the outset, he was asked to explain as to why the report asked for vide ibid Show Cause Notice, which was to be sent by 18.07.2021, has not been sent. He explained that even though the Show Cause Notice had been received on 02.07.2021, he had asked Shri Pankaj Kumar, FSO to prepare the reply but he did not do so and on his transfer, he has been relieved on 20.07.2021. This reply is not satisfactory because it was his primary duty to get the reply prepared and send it to the Commission by 18.07.2021. Shri Pankaj Kumar has been relieved on 20.07.2021 but the date for submission of reply was prior to that i.e. 18.07.2021. Therefore, he should have ensured submission of reply by 18.07.2021 for which he is squarely responsible.

2. Thereafter, he was asked to explain the cases of delay but unfortunately, he started staring at his subordinates for information and began with the cases of last three years without even going through the contents of the Show Cause Notice. He admitted that he has not read the Show Cause Notice because in that; information only since 01.04.2020 till 30.04.2021 had been asked for. When he was asked to explain each case of delay, he was completely clueless. When he started explaining two cases of delay, applications for which were submitted on 19.05.2020 and 27.05.2020, he could not give reply to any of the observations of the Commission. Consequently, he requested for time to prepare the reply and to send it to the Commission. This kind of attitude towards official duties shows gross negligence of duties and irresponsible behaviour on the part of the Shri Gulshan Kalra, who being Deputy Director, is overall incharge of Gurugram as far as fire services are concerned.

3. His request for time is accepted as a special case and he is directed to send complete details of delayed cases by 23.07.2021 evening in the following format:-

Note: While calculating the delay, he should take 'days' as 'working days'.

If he fails to submit this information by 23.07.2021 evening, Commission will be constrained to take coercive measures by exercising the powers of the Civil Court. He is further directed to appear before the Commission in person at 10.00 am on 30.07.2021 alongwith files of delayed cases.
