Final Orders

in respect of Suo Moto notice no. HRTSC/File No.111/HRTSC/SM - 203/2092 dated 20.05.2022.

1. These orders are being passed in continuation of interim orders dated 1st July, 2022 in this case.
2. With reference to the interim orders, information has been provided by DGP, Haryana vide letter no.7597/GA-3 dated 8 July, 2022. It has been mentioned that one case of Addition/Deletion of weapon was disposed off beyond RTS timeline in the month of April, 2022. Giving details of the case, it has been mentioned that CP Faridabad requested National Rifle Association of India to verify the recommendations which had been submitted by the applicant. It has been submitted that after verification report was received on 21.04.2022 and after completing all codal proceedings/formalities, the said service was provided. Though there was minor delay, it was not beyond RTS timeline was intentionally delayed. Regarding 19 applications received for verification of fresh Arms Licenses in the month of March, 2022, it has been stated that these files are actually with the user (under process) but were inadvertently shown as "Disposed off beyond time" by his office while sending the consolidated report to the Commission. Inconvenience caused in this regard has been regretted.
3. The Commission has carefully considered all facts and circumstances of the case. The reasons given for the cases shown as delayed in the earlier report have been found to be satisfactory and therefore, the suo moto notice is hereby filed with the advice that the concerned officers of the office of DGP, Haryana should carefully check the information before sending the same to the Commission.
