**Interim Orders**

**(In respect of suo moto notice no. HRTSC/file no.112/SM-204/  
2022/2103 dated 23.05.2022).**

An email was received from the complainant, Ms. Megha Gupta dated 25.08.2022. (copy enclosed) stating that the conveyance deed has still not been issued to her despite the orders of the Commission dated 23.06.2022. The case was taken up for consideration today and the relevant orders of the Commission dated 23.06.2022 are reproduced as under:-

“At the same time, the Chief Administrator, HSVP is directed to implement the orders of the Administrator HSVP, Faridabad subject to the decision of the Appellate Authority within 15 days of these orders so that justice is done to the complainant.”

Sh. Ajit Balaji Joshi, has challenged the orders of the Commission by filing a CWP No. 15442 of 2022 in which only the imposition of penalty as well as payment of compensation to the complainant has been stayed by the Hon'ble High Court. However, there is no stay on rest of the order i.e either regarding implementation of the orders of the Appellate Authority i.e Administrator, HSVP, Faridabad or regarding observations of the Commission regarding working of the Respondent or on sending of the case to the State Government/HIPA as a case study. Therefore, by not executing the conveyance deed, the respondent is continuously denying delivery of a notified service. However, before imposing the penalty again, a show cause notice is hereby issued to him to respond as to why the orders of the Commission to this extent have not been implemented so far. The reply should be sent to the Commission by 5<sup>th</sup> September, 2022 failing which ex-parte orders shall be passed on merits.
