

**Final Orders**

**(In respect of Suo Moto notices No. HRTSC/File No.150/SM-310/4976 dated 16.11.2022 issued to Sh. Vijay Kumar, Sub Divisional Engineer-cum-Designated Officer, PHED, Sirsa)**

1. A complaint was received from Sh. Jagdish & Others R/o Ward No 1, Chattargarh Patti, Sirsa vide e-mail dated 24.08.2022 stating that a 200 ft long sewerage line of around 15 houses had been destructed when another development work was undertaken by a Govt. contractor in the area and the residents of the concerned area had been adversely affected due to the same. The complainant had filed multiple complaints for the last 1.5 months to the concerned authorities, but had been unable to resolve the issue. Taking cognizance of the matter since the issue relates to a notified service, a letter dated 31.08.2022 followed by a reminder dated 28.09.2022 was sent to Sub-Divisional Engineer-cum- Designated Officer, PHED, Sirsa to take cognizance and furnish an action taken/status report to the Commission. However, no reply was received in this matter. Thus, a suo moto notice was issued to Sh. Vijay Kumar, Sub-Divisional Engineer-cum- Designated Officer, PHED, Sirsa, Haryana to ascertain the reasons for not responding to the communications of the Commission, delay in delivery of a notified service beyond the notified timelines and to further decide as to why a penalty of ₹20,000 may not be imposed upon him and a compensation of ₹5,000 may not be paid to the applicant in this case for his act of omission.
2. A response dated 23.11.2022 has been received from Sh. Vijay Kumar wherein he has mentioned that the initial letter dated 31.08.2022 from the Commission along with complaint was addressed to him but was mailed to the the O/o Executive Engineer, PHED Divn No. 1, Sirsa on the email id: [cepsirsa@gmail.com](mailto:cepsirsa@gmail.com), the same was endorsed to his office by the O/o Executive Engineer, PHED Divn No. 1, Sirsa on 02.09.2022. Taking cognizance of the complaint, he rectified the complaint & the same was intimated to O/o EE, PHED, Sirsa vide letter dated 21.09.2022. He has also submitted that the same complaint was lodged on CM Window portal, for which an Action Taken Report was prepared by Sh. Haripinder Sharma, Eminent Person, CM Window after the complaint was rectified by his office and the complaint was filed. In reference to the reminder sent by the Commission dated 28.09.2022 (response due date 14.10.2022), a response was sent by the Xen, PHED, Sirsa to the Commission on 17.11.2022. However, the suo moto notice had already been issued on 16.11.2022.



3. In response to the suo moto notice, hearing was conducted on 09.12.2022 at 12:00 Noon. Sh. Vijay Kumar, SDE, PHED, Sirsa submitted that pro-active steps had been taken by his office when the complaint was received via CM Window and the Commission. However, the reply could not be submitted in adequate time. After considering the facts and submissions of the case, the Commission is filing the suo notice issued to Sh. Vijay Kumar, SDE, PHED, Sirsa as the complaint has now been resolved and his submissions in the matter are satisfactory.
