Final Orders

(In respect of Suo-moto notice no. HRTSC/File no.161/SM-327/5400 dated 19.12.2022 issued to Sh. R.S. Dhillon, IAS, Director, Social Justice and Empowerment Department, Govt. of Haryana)

1. Sh. Kishori Lal R/o Mahendergarh had submitted a complaint vide letter dated 22.06.2022 informing that they hadn't received their Old Age Pension since September, 2021. The complainant had attached a letter dated 24.12.21 written by DSWO-Narnaul to the SJE HQ informing that earlier the income of the complainant had been shown as Rs. 5,00,000 (because of which the pension was stopped it seems) but the complainant had gotten the same corrected to Rs.50,000. Taking cognizance of the issue as it is a notified services at no.179 namely 'Old age Samman allowance (pension scheme)' a letter no.3467 dated 18.08.2022 followed by reminder dated 08.09.2022 was sent to the Director, Social Justice & Empowerment Department, Haryana to take cognizance and furnish action taken/status report to the Commission by 30.08.2022 and 24.09.2022 respectively. In reference, memo no.12480 dated 22.09.2022 was received vide which it was informed that the pension of the complainant was stopped owing to higher income shown on PPP earlier and revised data has now been received from CRID, based on which pension will be disbursed to the complainant from September, 2022. Subsequently, a letter no.4275 dated 06.10.2022 followed by reminder dated 09.11.2022 were sent to the Director, Social Justice & Empowerment Department, Haryana to explain as to why the correction had not been effected on receipt of letter dated 24.12.2021 from DSWO-Narnaul, seeking reply by 22.10.2022 and 20.11.2022 respectively. The Commission did not receive any reply on these two letters. Thus, a suo-moto notice was issued to Sh. R.S. Dhillon, IAS, Director, Social Justice & Empowerment Department, Haryana to ascertain the reasons for not responding to the Communications of the Commission, delay in delivery of notified service and to further decide as to why a penalty of Rs.20,000 may not be imposed upon him and a compensation of ₹5000 may not be paid to the applicant in this case for his act of omission. He was asked to submit his reply by 30.12.22.

2. A reply dated 20.12.22 was received from him. It informed that the pension arrears from the period between September, 2021- July, 2022 had now been credited to the complainant. It still did not answer Commission's query regarding inaction on DSWO-Narnaul's letter dated 24.12.21. Hence, another letter dated 02.01.23 was written to him seeking this explanation. On not receiving answer to this specific query in his reply dated 06.01.23 also, he was called for a hearing before the Commission on 19.01.23.

3. On 19.01.23, Sh. Shamsheer Singh, Superintendent. SJE HQs and Ms. Poonam Gupta, System Analyst, SJE HQs attended the hearing on behalf of Director, SJE. They informed that the correction cited in DSWO-Narnaul's letter dated 24.12.21 was, in fact, a self-declaration of income by the complainant and not verified yet and
