SKILLS TAUGHT IN ITI

- Work with a wide range of tools like testing devices, soldering irons, wire cutters, standard tools (hammers, screwdrivers), and power tools (used to cut conduit pipes & drill holes)
- Repair electrical wiring and components at homes and Industries.
- Use cable lugs and crimping tools to install under ground cables
- Plan, and estimate costs of different types of wiring systems
- Plan, draw, estimate material requirement, wire up, and test different commercial and computer networking wiring circuits as per indian electricity rules
- Select, assemble, test and wire-up control panel wiring
- Install electronic components like rectifiers, inverters, and other electronic devices
- Install and wire up AC induction motor (single and three phase) with starters

- Inspect electrical systems and equipment
