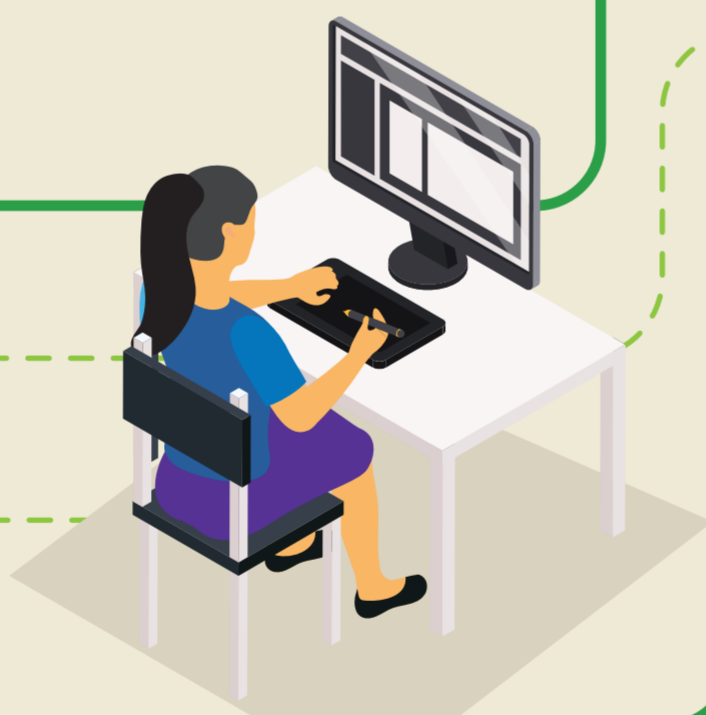


SKILLS TAUGHT IN ITI

- Surveying techniques like chain survey, compass survey, plane table survey, theodolite survey, and total station survey
- Set up GPS (Global Positioning System) or DGPS (Differential Global Positioning System) for data collection
- Prepare a site plan / map / set coordinates
- Building estimation using AutoCAD

- Computer efficiency - eg. Computer Aided design (CAD) & Global Positioning system (GPS)
- Analytical and problem-solving skills
