#### THE CONSTITUTION (SCHEDULED CASTES) ((UNION TERRITORIES)) ORDER 1951 . C.O. 32

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of article 341 of the Constitution of India, as amended by the · Constitution (First Amendment) Act, 1951, the President is pleased to make the following Order, namely-

- 1. This Order may be called the Constitution (Scheduled Castes) 2[(Union Territories)] Order, 1951.
- 2. Subject to the provisions of this Order, the eastes, races or tribes or parts of, or groups within, eastes or tribes, specified in [Parts I to III] of the Schedule to this Order shall, in relation to the [Union territories] to which those parts respectively relate, be deemed to he Scheduled Castes so far as regards members thereof resident in the localities specified in relation to them respectively in those Parts of that Schedule.
- (3. Notwithstanding anything contained in paragraph 2, no person who professes a religion different from the Hindu, 'fthe Sikh or the Ruddhist] religion shall be deemed to be a member of a Scheduled Caste.
- 14. Any reference in this Order to a Union territory in Part I of the Schedule shall be construed as a reference to the territory constituted as a Union territory, as from the first day of November, 1956, any reference to a Union territory in Part II of the Schedule shall be construed as a reference to the territory constituted as a Union territory as from the first day of November, 1966 and any reference to a Union territory in Part III of the Schedulo shall be construed as a reference to the territory constituted as a Union territory as from the day appointed under clause (b) of section 2 of the Goa, Daman and Diù Reorganisation Act, 1987.)

Sub: Two judgment delivered by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi – W.P.(C) No. 2943/2013 regarding appointment in teaching posts related and W.P. (C) No.4748/2013 admission related matter.

Sir.

This is with reference to Joint Registrar (Admissions), GGSIPU letter No. iPU-7/AR (Admissions)/Legal/2014/68/5630 dated 11/06/2014 on the subject cited above. The matter was referred to Law Department, Govt. of NCT of Delhi and I am directed to convey the advice received from Law Department, GNCT of Delhi is as under:

"The W.P. (C) No. 4748/2013 was related to the issue as to whether a person belonging to a community, which is notified to be a scheduled caste in another State, is entitled for admission to I.P. University. Hon'ble High Court held that the candidates belonging to communities, which are not included in the list of Scheduled caste for Delhi, in the Presidential order, will not be entitled to admission in I.P. University against the seats reserved for Scheduled Caste candidates. It was further held that the candidates belonging to communities included in the list of Scheduled caste for Delhi, in the Presidential order, will be entitled to admission in I.P. University only if they are residents of Delhi, in terms of the Presidential order dated 20th September, 1951, as amended from time to time, by the law made in this regard.

The issue regarding the reservation in admission in educational institutions has already been settled by the Council of Ministers vide Decision No. 1524 dated 08/05/2013 wherein the Cabinet had decided that the judgment of the Hon'ble High Court in the case of Kavita Khorwal Vs Delhi University & Ors may be accepted for implementation. In case of Kavita Khorwal Vs Delhi University & Ors (W.P.(C) No. 11056/2004 decided on 03/11/2008, Hon'ble High court of Delhi has held that in relation to the Union Territory of Delhi, for admissions to institutions managed and completely controlled by the Government of the National Capital Territory of Delhi, reservation under Article 15(4) can be enjoyed by only those caste groupings enlisted in the Scheduled Caste (Union Territory) Order, 1951, as regards Delhi, and subject to the conditions spelt out there. Member of the Castes and tribes who do not fulfil that description, and/or not described in that Order, would not be entitled to such benefits. This position was further upheld in the judgment dated 07/08/2013 in the barch of writ petitions including the W.P.(C) No. 4748/2013 while making it clear that the judgment in case of Deepak Kumar & Crs. was concerned only with the employment under the Government of Delhi and not with the admissions to the educational institutes set up by the State Government (ref. page 412/C). The W.P. (C) No. 4748/2013 is specifically for admission in IP University. Therefore, there seems to be interconflict involved in the matter."

Accordingly, you are requested to take further necessary action in the matter.
