To identify and include PWDs and their families located in rural and remote areas of Bundel Khand and provide supportive services as well as benefits of government schemes/ policies and programmes.

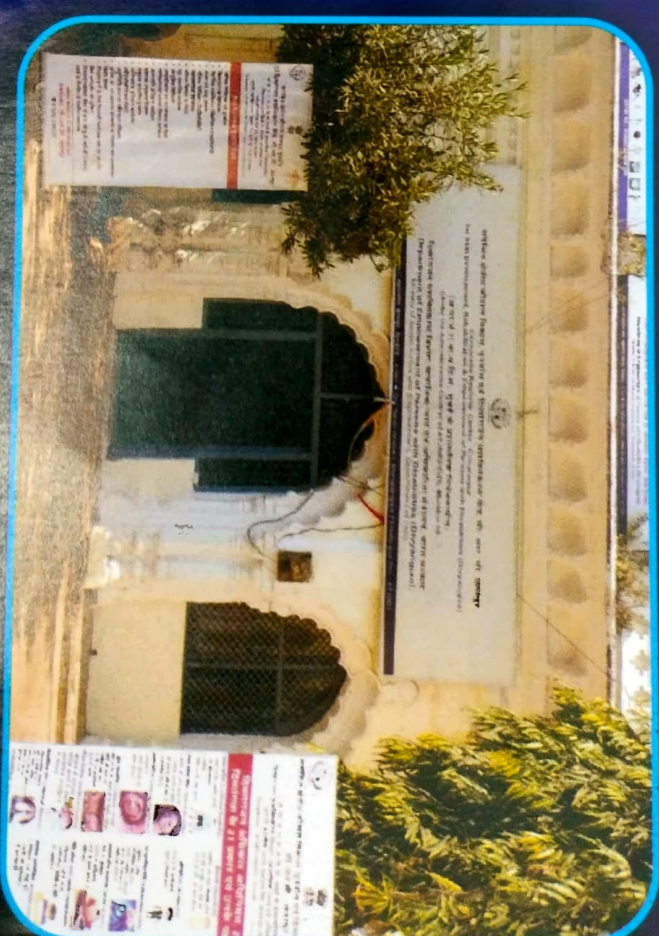
Research & Development

Composite Regional Centre for Skill Development, Rehabilitation, & Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, Chhatarpur is functioning under the administrative control of Ali Yavar Jung National Institute for Speech & Hearing Disabilities (Divyangjan), Mumbai, (Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan), Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India). CRC- Chhatarpur is working as composite regional centre since 8th April, 2023 with the objective of providing a number of centre based clinical and community-based rehabilitation services to persons with disabilities (PWDs) in Madhya Pradesh. It was inaugurated by Dr. Virendra Kumar, Hon'ble Union Minister, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India in the gracious presence of Shri Om Prakash Sakthlecha, Hon'ble cabinet Minister of MSME & Science and Technology, Govt. of Madhya Pradesh.

CRC- Chhatarpur is committed to provide rehabilitation services to all the disabilities specified in the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act 2016 which include the following conditions:

1. **Physical disability**
- A. **Locomotor disability**–
 - (a) leprosy cured person
 - (b) cerebral palsy
 - (c) dwarfism
 - (d) muscular dystrophy
 - (e) acid attack victims
- B. **Visual impairment**–
 - (a) blindness
 - (b) low-vision
- C. **Hearing impairment**–
 - (a) deaf
 - (b) hard of hearing
- D. **Speech and language disability**–
2. **Intellectual disability**
 - (a) specific learning disabilities
 - (b) autism spectrum disorder
3. **Mental behaviour,**
 - (a) mental illness
4. **Disability caused due to**
 - (a) chronic neurological conditions–

(b) Blood disorder–

- (i) haemophilia
- (ii) thalassemia

5. Multiple Disabilities (more than one of the above specified disabilities) including deaf blindness

Key Objectives

- To serve as Resource Centre for rehabilitation and special education of persons with disabilities.

- To undertake services of education and skill development leading to enhancement of opportunities for employment, rehabilitation, mobility communication recreation and integration in society.
- To undertake research and development with specific reference to needs of divers groups of people with disability, keeping in view the nature and severity of disability in the region.
- To develop strategies for delivery of rehabilitation services suitable to the socio-cultural background of the region.
- To stimulate growth of services by encouraging and supporting voluntary organization, parents groups and self – help groups.
- To establish linkages with existing medical, educational and employment services, following the principles of community-based rehabilitation and offer extension services in the rural area.
