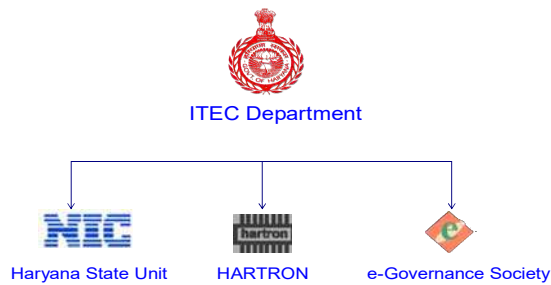

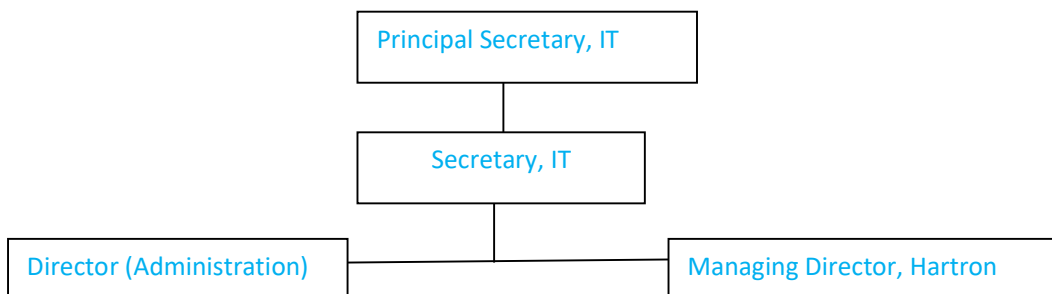

Activities and achievement of the Information Technology, Electronics and Communication Department, Haryana.

Department has been rolling out various IT initiatives in line with the vision of Digital India and its pillars. Some of the key initiatives taken by the Department are as under;

- **e-Kharid:** Bringing transparency in the food procurement process. Approx. 10 Lakh gate passes have been issued and payment files of more than Rs. 40,000 Crore have been sent to the Bank for disbursal to the farmers through this portal.
- **JanSahayak m-Governance initiative:** Haryana has conceptualized the concept of "Gateway to Government" State level Mobile platform for all G2C services in all departments. Provides a single point of interface to citizens for accessing all Government Services, Emergency Helplines and other information services.
- **Mukhya Mantri Antyodaya Parivar Utthan Yojana (MMAPUY):** The objective is to uplift the economic status of those families in the State whose annual income is less than 1 lakh based on the income characteristics available in Family Identity Card database (PPP). 96808 families have been surveyed with the help of mobile app as on date.
- **Antyodaya SARAL:** SARAL has transformed citizen service delivery in Haryana through complete digitization. Total 557 State G2C Services/ Schemes pertaining to 45 Departments/ Boards/ Corporations are being provided through this platform.
- **Cashless Haryana:** Haryana Cashless Consolidated portal was launched to monitor the digital/ cashless transactions with an objective to promote digital payments and achieve less-cash society. As on date 483.32 Cr.+ digital transactions have been recorded.
- **B1 Lower School Entrance Test Portal:** A state-of-the-art portal with features like keyless exam, real-time result, randomization of question bank at the topic level and high amount of security with custom Dashboards. Successfully conducted in state in which more than 15000 (8000+ in 2018 & 6200+ in 2019 batch) police staff appeared.
- **UMANG:** First State to onboard Services on UMANG Platform in 2018-19. Initially 15 Services of Revenue & Disaster Management developed under e-District Project, 3 Services of Transport Department, 5 Services of PHED & 2 Services of SARAL Status tracking was on boarded on UAMNG.

Some of the initiatives taken by Government of Haryana during the COVID-19 crisis are as under:

- **Haryana Atmanirbhar Portal:** Atmanirbhar Haryana Portal is being used to extend the Financial & Banking Services of Haryana to the residents of the State such as **Haryana Interest Subvention Scheme** – For Differential Rate of Interest Scheme (DRI) Loan, Shishu Loan (Mudra Scheme) and Education Loan, **Haryana Bank Slot Booking** and the **Cash Delivery at Home**
- **Healthy Haryana Portal and Mobile App:** Created to carry out the door-to-door household survey to detect Influenza like illness (ILI) and Febrile Acute Respiratory Infection (FARI) symptomatic patients using android-based mobile App. As on date, more than 21,580 surveyors have carried out health survey of more than 6.73 Lakh households.
- **Covid Sangharsh Senani Portal:** As on date, more than 77,500 Kiryana/vegetable/ milk/ chemist shop owners and more than 89,925 volunteers have been registered to provide services & help citizens fight against Coronavirus.
- **Haryana Covid Sample Report Portal:** Captures data of test results of COVID-19 samples done by COVID-19 labs for the State. As on date, 19 (14 Government + 9 Private) labs have been registered and more than 3 Lakhs patient samples have been tested.

Apart from the above initiatives, **more than 20 additional Covid related projects** have been developed and implemented in the State.

Other Applications:

- **Meri Fasal Mera Bayara (MFMB):** MFMB portal developed by NIC Haryana for farmers to self-report crop sown information along with land & bank account details.
- **Atal Seva Kendras (ASKs):** 18,552 ASKs (12,845 in rural areas and 5,707 in urban areas) have been registered in the State.
- **eOffice:** The eOffice has been implemented and as on date, more than 22,287 employees of 92 Departments & 22 Districts including field offices are working on eOffice. More than 4 Lacs eFiles & eReceipts has been created & more than 17 Lacs eFile & eReceipts has been moved.
- **Mukhya Mantri Bagwaani Bima Yojana (MMBBY) Portal:** This portal is proposed to give an option to the farmers growing horticulture crops to buy crop insurance and get compensation for losses due to adverse weather and natural calamities. This portal is not launched yet.
- **Center of Excellence for Blockchain:** Government of Haryana is planning to set up a Centre of Excellence for “Block Chain” Technology at STPI Gurugram with State of Art Incubation facilities admeasuring approximately

10000 Sq. ft. Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between STPI & State Government is under process.

- **Aadhaar (UIDAI) Services:** DITECH is nodal agency and acting as an AUA supporting 25+ Sub AUA departments in State and capacity building of department w.r.t following the guidelines issued by UIDAI.
- **Mobile SMS Services:** SeMT is handling DITECH SMS Gateway provided through CDAC and catering to 70+ applications of user departments of the State. Approximately 27 Cr SMS have been sent through this Gateway in last 3 Years
- **One Time Registration Portal:** Web-based integrated workflow system wherein applicants can register for Group C & D and non-gazetted teaching posts in the Government via one time registration process managed by Haryana Staff Selection Commission. As on date, more than 11 lakh registrations have been done at this portal.
- **Wi-Fi hotspot facility:** 8468 Wi-Fi hotspots have been deployed in Gram Panchayats (GPs).
- **Incubation Centres/ Start-Up Hub:** Innovation and Start-up Hub in Gurugram is operational (area of 1,20,000 Sft.) providing world class infrastructure & facilities to the Start-up Ecosystem Stakeholders including NASSCOM 'Centre of Excellence for Internet of Things (CoE-IoT)'.
- **Digital Locker:** Haryana is front runner in utilizing Digital Locker platform with 26 documents of 9 Departments online and a Government Order backing the integration.
- **Workflow Based BPL Entitlement Portal:** The portal helps in submission of applications from citizens falling under Below Poverty Line (BPL) criteria. More than 9.72 Lakh BPL registrations have been done till now on this portal.
- **Haryana – Real time Automated Feedback Dashboard (H-RAFD):** H-RAFD provides an online mechanism for getting feedback from citizens on e-services provided by State Government in Haryana through various channels like SMS, Web, Mobile app, etc. 392 services of 33 Departments has been integrated with H-RAFD as on date.
- **Bharat Net:** 6204 Gram Panchayats (GPs) of State have been declared service ready by Bharat Broadband Network Ltd. (BBNL) under Bharat Net project of Govt. of India.

सूचना प्रौद्योगिकी, इलैक्ट्रॉनिक्स एवं संचार विभाग की गतिविधियां एवं उपलब्धियाँ वर्ष 2022

विभाग डिजिटल इण्डिया और इसके स्तम्भों के अनुरूप आईटी की विभिन्न पहल संचालित कर रहा है। विभाग द्वारा की गई कुछ प्रमुख पहल इस प्रकार हैं:-

ई-खरीद: जिसका उद्देश्य खाद्यान्न खरीद प्रक्रियाओं के सभी स्तरों पर पारदर्शिता लाना है। अब तक इस प्लेटफॉर्म के माध्यम से लगभग 10 लाख गेट पास जारी किये जा चुके हैं और किसानों को अदायगी करने के लिए 40,000 करोड़ रुपये की अदायगी फाइलें बैंक को भेजी गई हैं।

जन सहायक एम. शासन पहल : सभी विभागों ने नागरिकों के लिए (जी2सी) सेवाओं को राज्यस्तरीय मोबाइल प्लेटफॉर्म के लिए हरियाणा ने गेटवे टू गवर्नमेंट की अवधारणा को नया रूप दिया है। यह नागरिकों को एक ही स्थल पर उपलब्ध करवाने की एक सरकारी पहल है तथा इसके द्वारा आपातकालीन हैल्पलाइन और अन्य सूचना सेवाएं दी गई हैं।

मुख्यमंत्री अंत्योदय परिवार उत्थान अभियान (एम.एम.ए.पी.यू.ए.) : इस अभियान का उद्देश्य राज्य की ऐसे परिवारों का आर्थिक उत्थान करना है, जिनकी वार्षिक आय एक लाख रुपये से कम है। परिवार पहचान पत्र आंकड़ा आधार (पीपीपी) में उपलब्ध आय विशेषताओं के आधार पहचान की गई है। अब तक मोबाइल एप के माध्यम से 96808 परिवारों का सर्वेक्षण किया जा चुका है।

अंत्योदय सरल : सरल ने पूर्णतः डिजिटाइजेशन के माध्यम से हरियाणा में नागरिक सेवा प्रदायगी में महत्वपूर्ण बदलाव किया है। इस समय हरियाणा में 45 विभागों/बोर्डों/निगमों की 557 राज्य सरकार से नागरिक (जी2सी) सेवाएं/स्कीमें सरल पोर्टल के माध्यम से प्रदान की जा रही हैं।

कैशलेस हरियाणा : हरियाणा कैशलेस समेकित पोर्टल विकसित और शुरू किया गया। राज्य सरकार का उद्देश्य डिजिटल अदायगी को बढ़ावा देना और कम नकदी समाज का निर्माण करना है। अब तक 483.32 करोड़ से अधिक डिजिटल लेनदेन दर्ज किया जा चुका है।

बी1. लोअर स्कूल प्रवेश परीक्षा पोर्टल : यह अत्याधुनिक पोर्टल बिना चाबी की परीक्षा की तरह, वास्तविक समय के परिणाम, विषय स्तर पर प्रश्न बैंक का यादृच्छिकरण, तत्काल प्रश्नपत्र वृद्ध और कस्टम डैशबोर्ड के साथ उच्च मात्रा में सुरक्षा जैसी सुविधाओं के साथ दी गई हैं। यह परीक्षा प्रदेश भर में सफलतापूर्वक आयोजित की गई, जिसमें 15000 से अधिक (2018 बैच में 8000+ और 2019 बैच में 6200+) पुलिस अमले ने परीक्षा दी।

उमंग : 2018-19 में उमंग प्लेटफॉर्म पर सेवाएं देने वाला पहला राज्य है। प्रारंभ में ई-डिस्ट्रिक्ट परियोजना के तहत विकसित राजस्व और आपदा प्रबंधन की 15 सेवाएं, परिवहन विभाग की 3 सेवाएं, पीएचईडी की 5 सेवाएं और सरल स्थिति ट्रेकिंग की 2 सेवाएं यूएएमएनजी पर शामिल थी।

हरियाणा सरकार द्वारा बटप.19 संकट के दौरान की गई कुछ पहल इस प्रकार हैं:-

- हरियाणा आत्मनिर्भर पोर्टल : इस पोर्टल का उपयोग राज्य के नागरिकों को हरियाणा की विस्तृत वित्तीय व बैंक सेवाएं प्रदान करने के लिए किया जा रहा है : हरियाणा ब्याज माफी स्कीम – विभिन्न ब्याज दरों पर ऋण स्कीम, शिशु ऋण (मुद्रा स्कीम) और शिक्षा ऋण । हरियाणा बैंक स्लॉट बुकिंग व घर पर नकदी का वितरण ।
- स्वस्थ हरियाणा पोर्टल एवं मोबाइल ऐप : एंड्रॉयड आधारित मोबाइल का प्रयोग करके इंप्लुएंजा जैसी बीमारी और श्वसन तंत्र के तीव्र संक्रमण के लक्षणों वाले मरीजों का घर-घर जाकर सर्वेक्षण करने के लिए यह विकसित किया गया है। आज तक 21,580 सर्वेक्षकों ने मोबाइल सर्वे अनुप्रयोग का प्रयोग किया है और 6.73 लाख से भी अधिक परिवारों का स्वास्थ्य सर्वेक्षण किया है।
- कोविड संघर्ष सेनानी पोर्टल : नागरिकों को सेवाएं प्रदान करने और कोरोना वायरस से लड़ने में सहायता करने के लिए अभी तक 77,500 करियाना/सब्जी/दूध/दवाइयों की दुकानों के मालिकों और 89,925 से अधिक स्वयंसेवकों का पंजीकरण किया जा चुका है।
- हरियाणा कोविड सेम्पल रिपोर्ट पोर्टल : राज्य भर से कोविड-19 लैब द्वारा जांच किये गये सेम्पल को इस पोर्टल के द्वारा प्राप्त किया जाता है। इस समय इस पोर्टल पर 19 (14 राजकीय+9 निजी) लैब पंजीकृत हैं और 3 लाख से अधिक मरीजों के सेम्पल की जांच की गई है।

उपरोक्त पहलुओं के अलावा कोविड से संबंधित 20 से अधिक अतिरिक्त परियोजनाएं विकसित और कार्यान्वित की गई हैं।

अन्य अनुप्रयोग :

- मेरी फसल मेरा ब्योरा (एमएफएमबी) : किसानों द्वारा बोई गई फसल की सूचना सहित भूमि और बैंक खाते की जानकारी स्वयं देने के लिए एनआईसी हरियाणा द्वारा एमएफएमबी विकसित किया गया है।
- अटल सेवा केन्द्र : राज्य में 18,522 अटल सेवा केन्द्र (12,845 ग्रामीण क्षेत्रों में और 5,707 शहरी क्षेत्रों में पंजीकृत किये गये हैं)
- ई-कार्यालय : ई-कार्यालय क्रियान्वित किया गया है और आज तक 92 विभागों व क्षेत्रीय कार्यालयों सहित 22 जिलों के 22,287 कर्मचारी ई-कार्यालय पर काम कर रहे हैं। चार लाख ई फाइल और ई-रिसिपिट्स सृजित की गई हैं और 17 लाख से अधिक ई-फाइल और ईरिसिपिट्स भेजी गई हैं।
- मुख्यमंत्री बागवानी बीमा योजना (एमएमबीबीवाई) पोर्टल: यह पोर्टल खराब मौसम और प्राकृतिक आपदाओं के कारण हुई हानि की क्षतिपूर्ति के लिए बागवानी किसानों द्वारा बीमा करवाने के लिए प्रस्तावित किया गया है। यह पोर्टल अभी शुरू नहीं हुआ है।
- सेंटर ऑफ एक्सीलेंस फॉर ब्लॉक चैन : हरियाणा सरकार एसटीपीआई गुरुग्राम में 10,000 वर्ग फुट में अति आधुनिक सुविधाओं से युक्त ब्लॉक चैन प्रौद्योगिकी के लिए एक सेंटर ऑफ

एक्सीलेंस स्थापित करने की योजना बनाई जा रही है। एसटीपीआई और राज्य सरकार के मध्य समझौता ज्ञापन की प्रक्रिया चल रही है।

- आधार (यू.आई.डी.ए.आई.) सेवाएं : सूचना प्रौद्योगिकी, इलेक्ट्रॉनिक्स एवं संचार विभाग हरियाणा एक नोडल अभिकरण व समस्त आधार एयूए सेवाओं का प्रबंध करता है और राज्य के 25+ उप एयूए विभागों की सहायता करता है और यूआईडीएआई द्वारा समय-समय पर जारी दिशा-निर्देशों पर चलते हुए विभागों की क्षमता का निर्माण करता है।
- मोबाइल एसएमएस सेवाएं : एस.ई.एम.टी. सी.डी.ए.सी. के माध्यम से प्रदत्त सूचना प्रौद्योगिकी, इलेक्ट्रॉनिक्स एवं संचार विभाग हरियाणा एसएमएस गेटवे का प्रबंधन करता है और प्रयोगकर्ता विभागों के 70+ अनुप्रयोगों की आवश्यकता की पूर्ति की गई है। पिछले 3 वर्षों में लगभग 27 करोड़ एसएमएस इस गेटवे के माध्यम से भेजी जा चुकी हैं।
- एक बार पंजीकरण पोर्टल : वैब आधारित एकीकृत कार्य प्रवाह प्रणाली जिसमें आवेदक हरियाणा कर्मचारी चयन आयोग द्वारा प्रबंधित प्रक्रिया के माध्यम से चतुर्थ व तृतीय श्रेणी के सरकारी पदों और अराजपत्रित शिक्षक के पदों के लिए एकमुष्ट पंजीकरण करवा सकते हैं। अब तक इस पोर्टल पर 11 लाख से अधिक पंजीकरण हो चुके हैं।
- वाई-फाई हॉटस्पॉट सुविधा : ग्राम पंचायतों में 8468 वाई-फाई हॉटस्पॉट लगाकर यह सुविधा प्रदान की गई है।
- इन्क्यूबेशन सेंटर्स/स्टार्टअप हब : गुरुग्राम में 1,20,000 वर्ग फुट क्षेत्र पर एक नवाचार एवं स्टार्टअप हब पूर्णतः संचालित है। इसमें विश्व स्तर का इन्फ्रास्ट्रक्चर और स्टार्टअप पारिस्थिति हितधारकों, जिसमें नेटकाम सेंटर ऑफ एक्सीलेंस फॉर इंटरनेट ऑफ थिंग्स (सीओई-आईओटी) की सुविधाएं प्रदान करता है।
- डिजिटल लॉकर : डिजिटल लॉकर को अपनाने में हरियाणा सरकार अग्रणी है। इस समय भारत सरकार की डिजिटल लॉकर सेवा के माध्यम से दस्तावेजों और प्रमाण पत्रों का डिजिटल तरीके से सत्यापन के लिए 9 विभागों के 26 दस्तावेज उपलब्ध हैं।
- कार्य प्रवाह आधारित बीपीएल पात्रता पोर्टल : यह पोर्टल गरीबी रेखा से नीचे (बीपीएल) के नागरिकों को अपना आवेदन भेजने में सहायता करता है। अब तक इस पोर्टल पर 9.72 लाख बीपीएल पंजीकरण किये जा चुके हैं।
- हरियाणा-रियल टाइम ऑटोमेटिड फीडबैक डैशबोर्ड (एच-आरएफडी) : एच-आरएफडी एसएमएस, मोबाइल ऐप आदि के माध्यम से हरियाणा में राज्य सरकार द्वारा प्रदान की जा रही ई-सेवाओं के लिए फीड बैक प्राप्त करने का एक आनलाइन तंत्र है। अब तक 33 विभागों की 392 सेवाओं को एच-आरएफडी पर सम्मिलित किया जा चुका है।
- भारत नेट : भारत सरकार की भारत नेट परियोजना के तहत भारत ब्राड बैंड नेटवर्क लिमिटेड (बीबीएनएल) भारत संचार निगम लिमिटेड (वीएसएनएल) ने हरियाणा राज्य की 6204 ग्राम पंचायतों को सेवा तैयार घोषित किया है।
