**Subject: Implementation of Grant of Permissions for Right of Way / Right of Use to CABLE TV Operators for laying the Cable TV infrastructure in the State.**

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to invite reference vide Notification No. Admn/368/1SIT/9487 dated 07th August, 2019 regarding Appendix 2 - 'Schedule of Charges' of Communication & Connectivity Infrastructure Policy (CCIP), 2017 (enclosed). As per the provisions of the aforementioned Policy, Cable TV Infrastructure is already covered under the purview of this policy and specific Sections / Clauses / Schedule of Charges pertaining to Cable TV explicitly mentioned under the policy/amendments are reiterated below:

- I. Under Section 2.2(e) of policy, it has been explicitly mentioned that the Communication and Connectivity Infrastructure include Ducts, underground OFC, cabling on the poles or electric poles.
- II. Under amended Appendix-2 of Policy pertaining to Schedule of Charges notified vide Notification No. Admn/368/1SIT/9487 dated 07th August, 2019, One-time Administrative Charges as well as Annual Charges for grant of license to Right of Way/Right of Use (including CABLE TV) have also been explicitly prescribed under Section-2 of Schedule of Charges.
- III. Under Appendix-3 (Sub-Para 2.2.1) of Policy, it has also been explicitly mentioned that the electric poles shall be allowed to lay overhead OFC/ Cable TV/ Communication cables.
- IV. Under Section 5.1 of policy, it has been explicitly mentioned that All applications for seeking permission to lay the communication infrastructure Above Ground or Under Ground, shall be submitted by the Applicant in Form 1 (Above Ground) and Form 2 (Under Ground) as the case may be along with all the particulars and documents specified in Appendix-1, through a portal already established by the Haryana State for ease of doing business.

Further, it is also bring into your kind notice that this Department has received complaints against the TV CABLE Operators regarding the unauthorized access and non-deposit of fee etc. This situation should not arise if the provisions of the above mentioned CCIP, 2017 are fully implemented in letter and spirit.
