Be it enacted by the Uttarakhand State Legislature in the Seventy Third Year of the Republic of India as follows-

Short title

1. This Act may be called the Uttarakhand Appropriation (Supplementary 2022-2023) Act, 2022.

From and out of the Consolidated Fund of Uttarakhand, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column-3 of the Schedule, amounting in the aggregate to the sums of Rs 54404291000 (Rs Five Thousand Four Hundred Forty Crore Forty Two Lakh Ninty One Thousand Only) towards defraying the several charges, which shall come in course of payment during the financial year 2022-23 ending on the 31st day of March, 2023 in respect of the services and purposes specified in column-2 of the Schedule.

Appropriation

3. The sums, authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of Uttarakhand by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes, expressed in the Schedule in relation to the financial year 2022-23 ending on the 31st day of March, 2023.
