THE UTTARAKHAND APPROPRIATION (SUPPLEMENTARY 2022-2023) ACT, 2022

(ACT NO. 11 OF 2022)

An

Act

to provide for the authorisation of payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State to the services for the financial years 2022-23 ending on the 31st day of March 2023.

Be it enacted by the Uttarakhand State Legislature in the Seventy Third Year of the Republic of India as follows-

From and out of the Consolidated Fund of Uttarakhand, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column-3 of the Schedule, amounting in the aggregate to the sums of Rs 54404291000 (Rs Five Thousand Four Hundred Forty Crore Forty Two Lakh Ninty One Thousand Only) towards defraying the several charges, which shall come in course of payment during the financial year 2022-23 ending on the 31 st day of March, 2023 in respect of the services and purposes specified in column-2 of the Schedule. |
| Appropriation | 3. The sums, authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of Uttarakhand by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes, expressed in the Schedule in relation to the financial year 2022-23 ending on the 31 st day of March, 2023. |

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

Article 204 of the Constitution of India read with article 205 requires that an Appropriation Bill should be introduced in the State Legislative Assembly after the demands for Supplementary Grants have been voted by the Legislative Assembly.

The proposed Bill make provision for the appropriation from and out of the Consolidated Fund of Uttarakhand of all moneys required to meet the Supplementary Grants made as approved by the Uttarakhand Legislative Assembly and expenditure charged upon the Consolidated Fund of the State in respect of Financial Year 2022-2023.
