To authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the year ending on thirty first day of March, 2018 -

Be it enacted by the State Assembly in the Sixty Eight year of the Republic of India as follows:-

short title

 This Act may be called the Uttarakhand Appropriation Act, 2017. Issue of Rs.399577835000 out of the Consolidated Fund of Uttarakhand for the year 2017-18

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Uttarakhand there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in Column-3 of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate[inclusive of the sums specified in column 12 of the Schedule to the Uttarakhand Appropriation (Vote on Account) Act, 2017 (Uttarakhand Act no. 100/XXXVI(3) / 2017/18(1)/2017 of 2017)] to the sums of Rs 399577835000 (Rs. Thirty Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty Seven Crore Seventy Eight Lakh Thirty Five Thousand only) towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the year ending on the thirty first day of March, 2018 in respect of the services and purposes specified in column 2 of the Schedule.

 The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of Uttarakhand by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the year ending on the thirty first day of March, 2018.

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

ARTICLE- 204 of the Constitution of India requires that an Appropriation Bill should be introduced in the State Legislature after the demands for grants have been voted by the Legislative Assembly, for incurring miscellaneous expenditure by the State from the Consolidated fund of the State. A provision is necessary for authorizing the payment and appropriation of certain sums, therefore;

This bill provides for the appropriation from and out of the Consolidated Fund of Uttarakhand of all moneys required to meet the Grants made by the Uttarakhand Legislative Assembly and the expenditure charged on the Consolidated Fund of the State in respect of the year ending on the thirty first day of March, 2018. This includes the appropriation of Moneys made under the Uttarakhand Appropriation (Vote on Account) Act, 2017 (Uttarakhand Act No. 100/xxxvi(3)/2017/18(1)/2017 of 2017).
